

Competition Rules and Expectations

- Birth Certificates are due upon registration. Can be emailed to revolutiondancemo@gmail.com.
- All dancers must be present in all classes and rehearsals during the week of the competition. If your child has an unexcused absence the week of competition their dance will be pulled with no refund.
- All dancers must arrive at the competition together as a team.
- Dancers must arrive in a jacket, pants, bow, earrings and backpacks. Hair must be in a low bun.
- One female parent or guardian must be present in the dressing room to assist with hair, makeup, and costume.
- Dressing room must stay neat, tidy, and clean.
- All rehearsing in the dressing room is prohibited. The Dance Director will rehearse with each dancer(s) at designated times. Dressing room stretching is allowed and encouraged once the dancer is ready.
- No eating or drinking in costume. (Water only)
- All tights should be run free. Please bring an extra pair of tights. NO UNDERWEAR is to be worn under tights.
- If you do not allow your dancer to participate in the SERENITY prayer please let the director know. The team will hold hands in group prayer before the first dance. We want to remain respectful of all religions so please feel free and comfortable to let us know if that is an issue.
- Videotaping and flash photography are prohibited at all competitions.
- All questions and concerns will be given to that competition's parent volunteer. Please do not take questions or concerns to the dance director unless it is private or an emergency.
- All dancers are required to stay for their awards and sit as a team.
- It is expected for all dancers and parents to be kind and courteous to other studios.
- Revolution Dance Jackets must be worn to all awards. Jacket can be with pants, costume, or Revolution Dance apparel. No street clothes are allowed during awards.
- Snacks will be signed up for and provided. Dancers are not to leave the competition to eat unless the schedule has allowed for the director to assign a break time. It is preferred that dancers do not leave.
- Dancers will be polite and appreciative of all awards given. Dancers will show the utmost good sportsmanship including clapping for other studios, saying congrats to those near you, etc. As a new studio, we want to always be known for not just our dancing but our grace and kindness.
- All parents must be dressed in Revolution Dance apparel or red white and blue. Parents are representing Revolution Dance just as dancers are.
- Parents in the audience are to give all Revolution Dance dancers a standing ovation. Every dancer in the studio will feel the full support of their team and dance family.
- Awards ending does not dismiss your dancer, the Dance Director does.
