Meeting:

Deciding budget - wanting to save as much money as possible for Pride - past budget was £50, Canva prices looking like £52. Margins for stickers £50 - £70.

Brochure? Brochure done by January - Blue has it already designed as a draft - want a map of town with our trained venues.

Community hall not applicable because there was no way to get in touch. SU have offered spaces, but don't want to alienate Aberystwyth non-student community. St Pauls - £22 an hour and 40 people. Penparcau space - bigger hall, only £20 an hour, projector, but further out of town. Walkable but difficult. Date - 26th of January - Monday night. Announce that we are working on Pride at this meeting. Voted on St Pauls because of easy location, do not think we will have more than 40 people - book for 3 hours so £66.

Action - before end of December - document for AGM - Connie.

Action - Blue add people into connections tab on notion.

Statement for Pride describing what we want to do and achieve - we also want to add in something along the lines of - thank you Aber Pride for letting us do this, we are going to try our best to bring community together.

PRIDE - Timetable for Pride - 25th April weekend. We need to do lots of fundraisers - Blue wants to hold more queer coffee mornings. Climate shop?

This weekend - announcement - Connie to make a google form for getting involved. Blue advertise Umbra's event & pride announcement post.

- Connie to talk to council and transport Wales wanting to do all the way from the university to the castle green. Ideally want it to end around noon at the Castle.
- Costs bandstand £200, food venders?, stage?, £700 marshalls, public liability £150, trustee insurance £20 a month, £55 to submit application and road sign - might need more road signs - about £20 each. Workshops - LGBTQ+ garden question time, drag makeup, circus skill classes,
