- Went through list of fundraiser ideas and confirmed plans - currently have: pub quiz, hell's angels, sponsored walk, transcend, bingo drag, pool tournament, game night, masquerade ball, talent show, battle of the bands, movie nights, queer film festival

- Voted on using Quickfencehire for the road closure for the march for Pride - cost will be £1,500 using metal barriers, traffic cones, staff, bilingual signs, all of the health and safety and risk assessment paperwork. - Voted unanimously to use them.
- Other expenditure for Pride - £92 for a charity to rent the bandstand - county council conversation - £138 for after 9 - 5
- Pride logistically - Cambrian Brass - 45 minute set welcoming to Pride - 10am gather welcome to pride at war memorial - us giving out brochures (canva? - need to factor in this cost) at 12 we march through town to the bandstand - speaker outside Baravin - information stand outside of bandstand with details of the event and also charities and stuffs - market in the bandstand - during the day and evening a lot of different events all going on around.

Training Update - SU done, four different locations all trained on the 12th of January - stickers are printed and ready - total number of locations currently trained - 2. Total trained within the month - 4 confirmed, and another 3 in progress.

- Voted on cost for vendors for Pride - £25 for a table.
- Went through responses of Pride volunteer form and went through actions for each volunteer and how each individual/group can help.
- Making a banner - event - fundraiser - make posters.
- We need to focus on kid-friendly events and we should focus on the community aspect of the event - this should be kid friendly during the day.
- Pride planning: plan of the day, Connie to contact individuals from form, Tiff to contact general volunteers, Jen to sort the drag show for Pride.

Bank account - awaiting official form acceptance - then bank account - yay.
