Treasurer Report

Lottie Roy presented the Wakulla County Coalition for Youth (WCCY) Second Quarter Treasurer's Report for March through May 2026. The coalition began the quarter with a balance of **\$3,491.37** as reflected on the April 1, 2026 bank statement. During the quarter, WCCY received revenue from several fundraising activities and events, including **\$1,296.00** from Champions for Change Brunch sponsorships, donations, and ticket sales, **\$100.00** from the Firehouse Subs Share Night fundraiser, and **\$131.00** from a Bake Sale Share Night event. Expenditures during the quarter included **\$341.25** for TAPCO Insurance, **\$70.00** for the annual SunBiz registration renewal, **\$228.48** in food purchases from Sam's Club and Walmart, **\$170.00** for Elavon online setup and service fees in April, **\$35.00** for Elavon service fees in May, and **\$50.00** for annual PayPal/MyMiniAuction dues. Following all receipts and disbursements, the coalition's account balance as of June 3, 2026 was **\$4,123.64**, which matched the bank statement. The Treasurer also noted that fundraising efforts conducted during April and May generated **\$751.27** in net proceeds.
