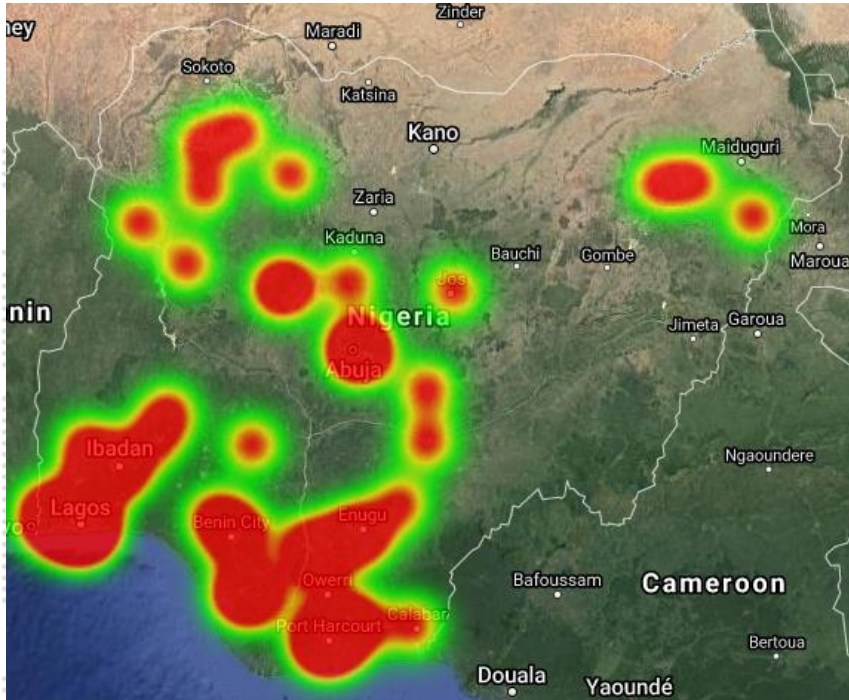

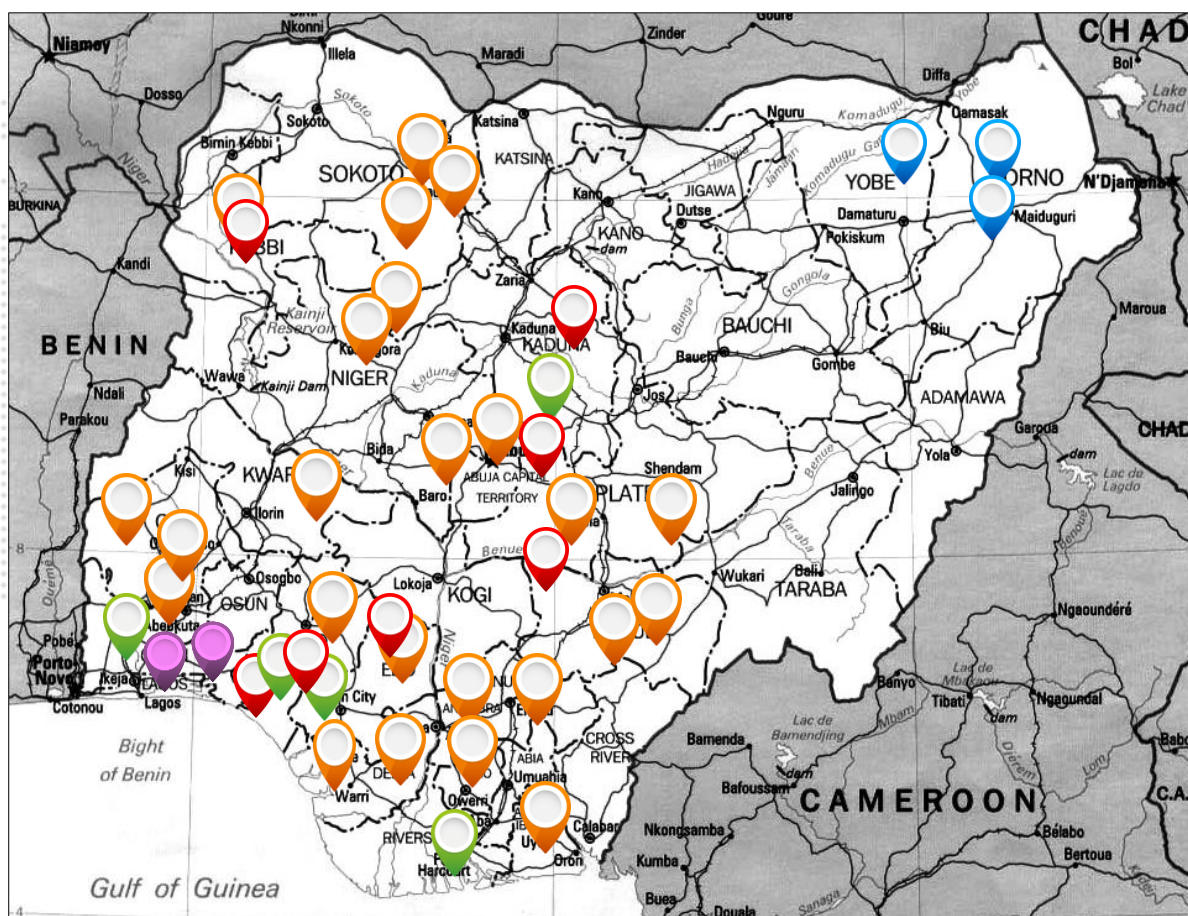

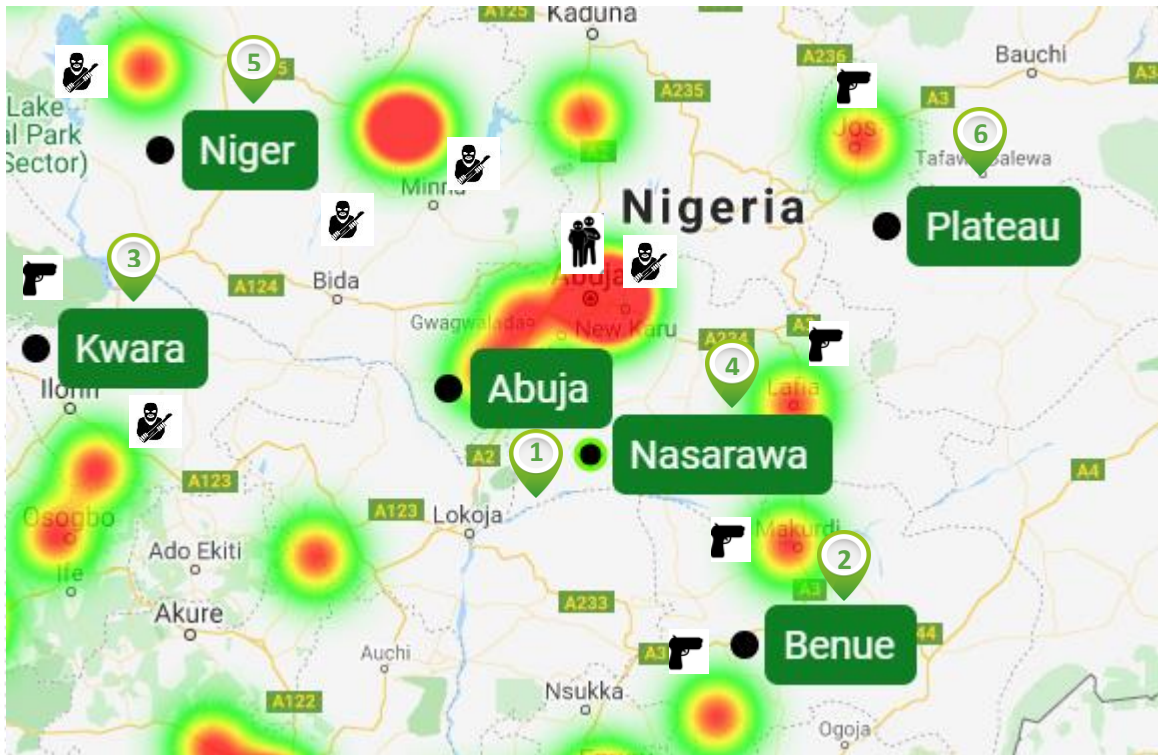
OVERVIEW OF INCIDENTS FOR THE WEEK

1. Another group of female students kidnapped from their school in North West and the trend of armed attacks have increased in Kebbi State.
2. Robbery incidents increase in the South west region specifically Lagos State.
3. Bandit activities increased in the North West as several incidents were recorded in Zamfara State.
4. The ban on Twitter remained during the reporting week and plans are in place to use NBC as the arbiter on social media clamp down.

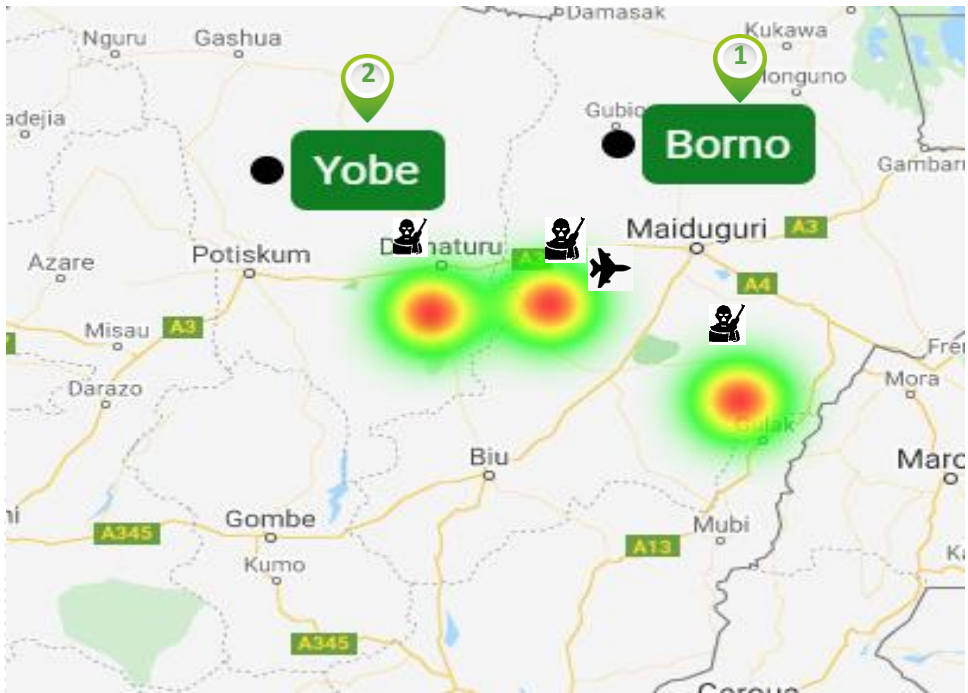

Incidents of the week – The week recorded an upsurge in bandit activities. Although the police killed at least 14 suspected bandits who attacked a police station in Benue State and recorded another 16 deaths in Niger State, there seem to be an overwhelming onslaught of bandit activities in these areas during the week. More persons were killed with an estimated 34 recorded in the week compared to 21 in the last reporting week. Also, 13 persons were kidnapped compared to one last week.

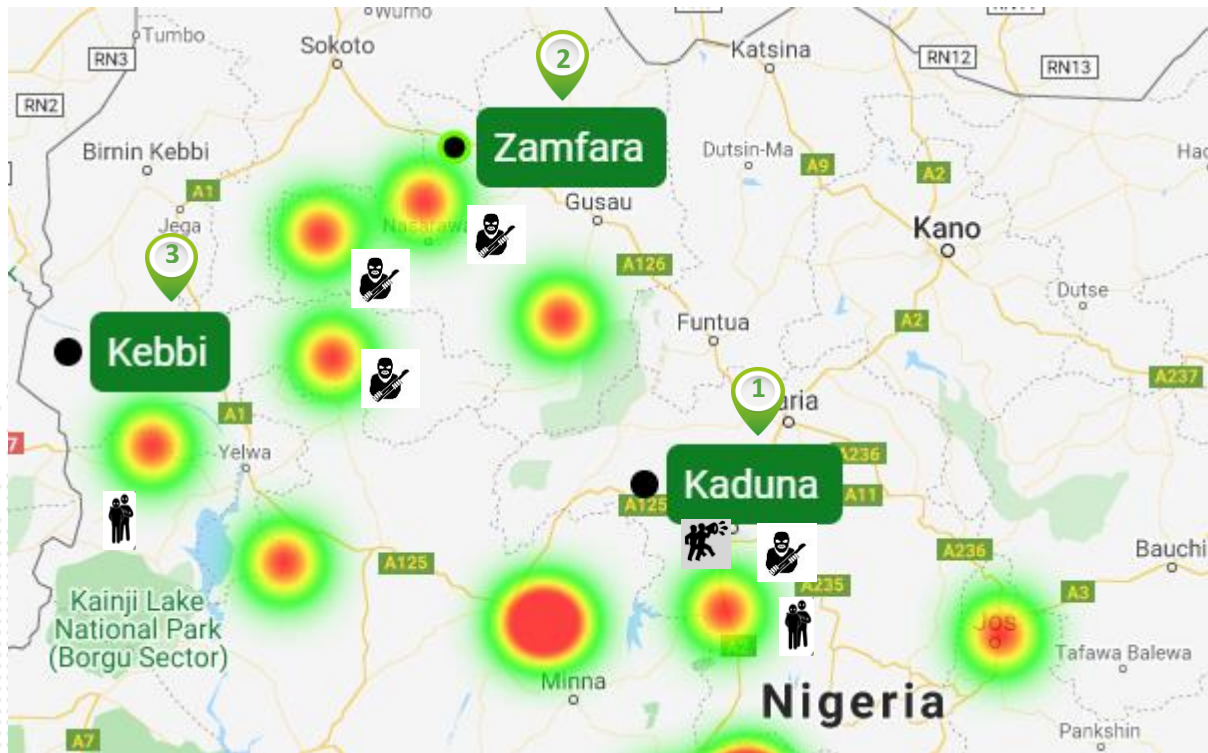

Incidents of the week – The Air Force conducted airstrikes after sighting ISWAP terrorists attacking Lamboa in Kaga LGA, Borno State on 20th June. At least a dozen of the assailants were killed in the airstrikes. The other incident occurred in Damboa where a military position was attacked. It was repelled and a total of 10 individuals including three soldiers were killed. Also, ISWAP terrorists attacked Gubja town in Yobe State killing three police officers. This was a targeted attack as the aim was to remove security manning the town for easier access. All occurring amidst information that Bakura Modu aka Shaba is the new Boko Haram leader.

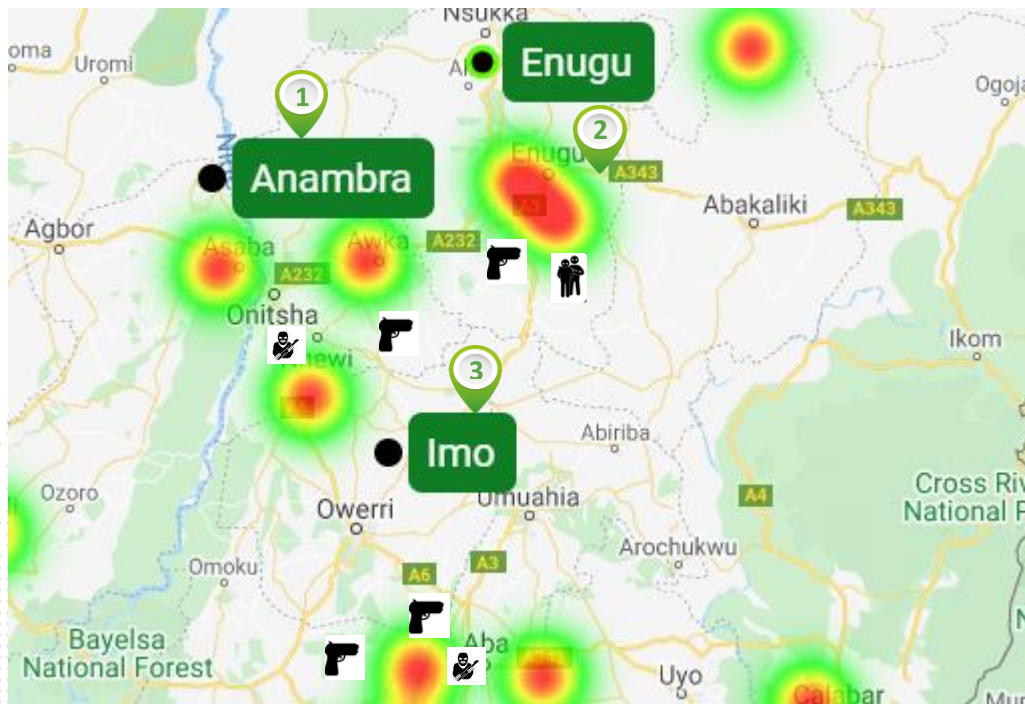

Incidents of the week – Kebbi State is recording an increase in bandit activities as a group of secondary school students were kidnapped from their school in Ngaski LGA in daylight on 17 June. This was after a group of women protested attacks in Zuru LGA on 14 June. Seven schools have been shut down indefinitely for safety reasons. In Zamfara State also, attacks were recorded against several communities between 14 and 19 June and several cattle about 700 were rustled by the assailants. Along the Kaduna – Abuja Highway, a protest was recorded, and it was alleged that at least 60 persons have been kidnapped along the route in a week while 10 others have been killed.

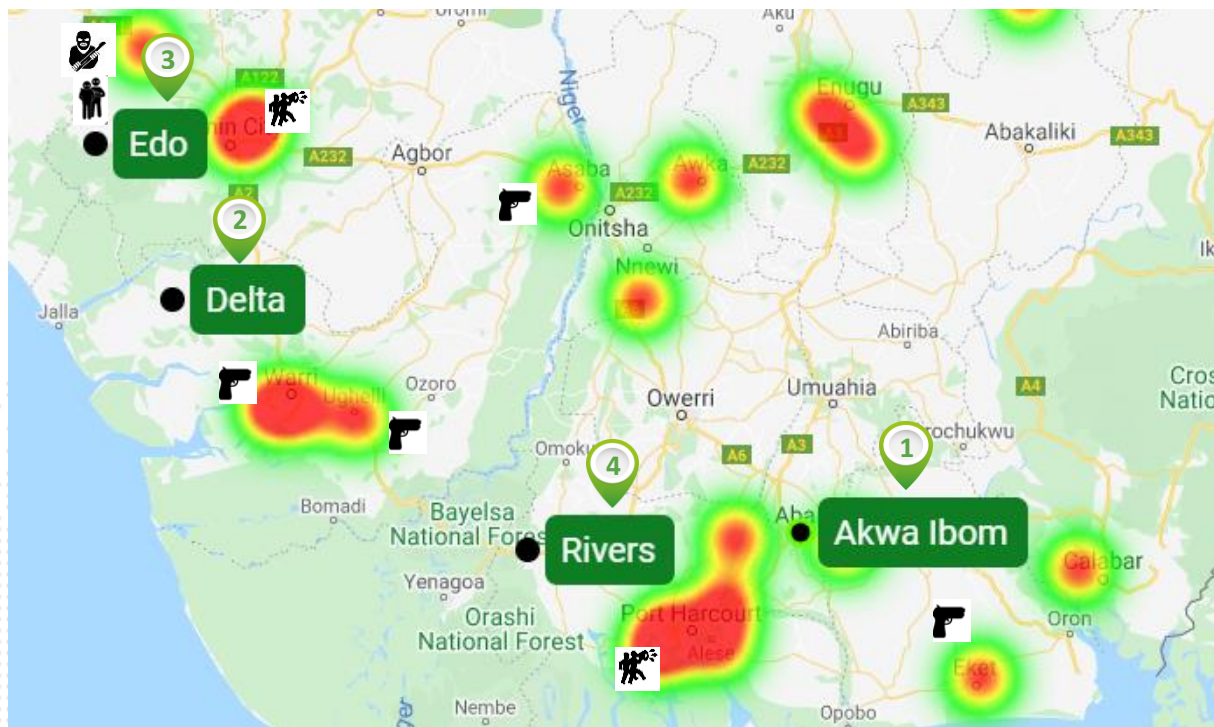

Incidents of the week – Attacks on police stations continued to decline during the week but number of persons killed from other types of incidents increased with 11 recorded during the week. Also, homes belonging to politicians were targeted in Imo State on 16 June with three country homes belonging to politicians incinerated by unknown assailants. Two persons were gruesomely killed during the incident as both deceased were decapitated.

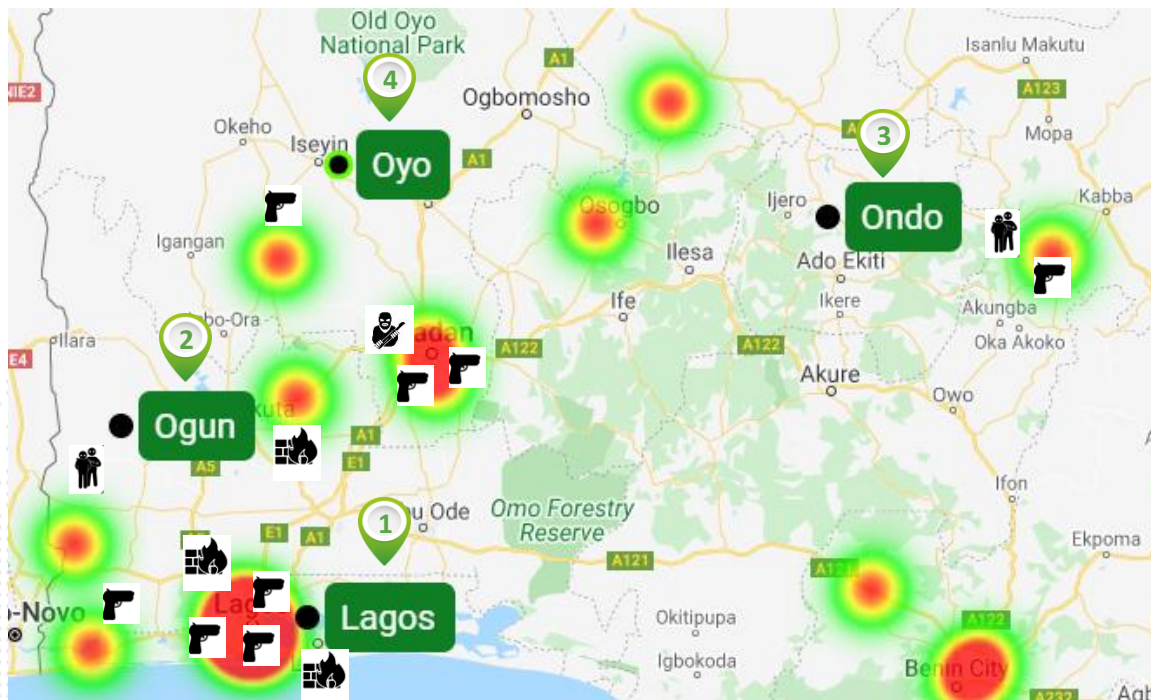

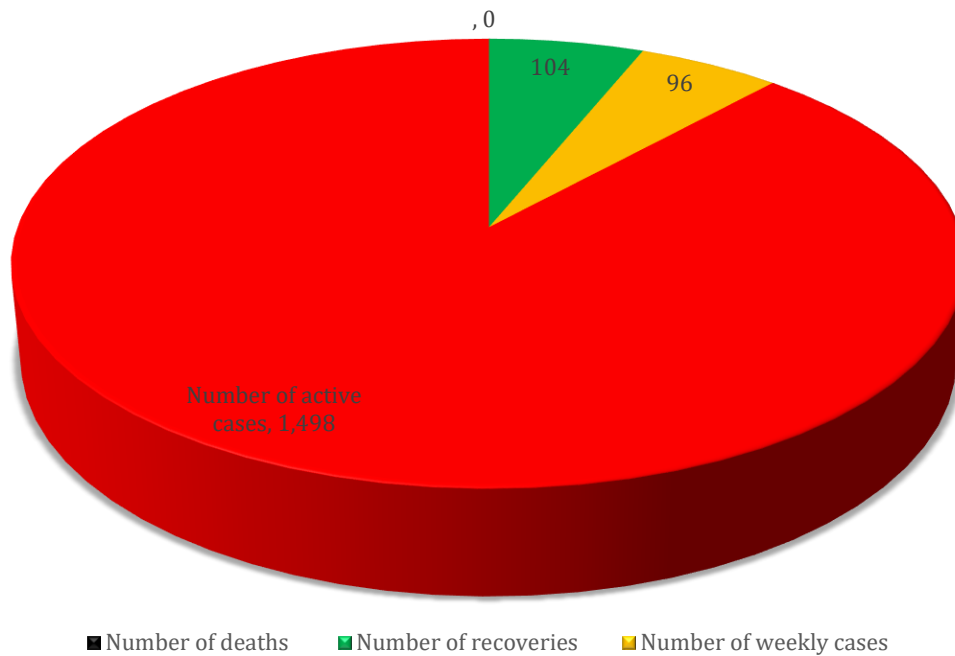

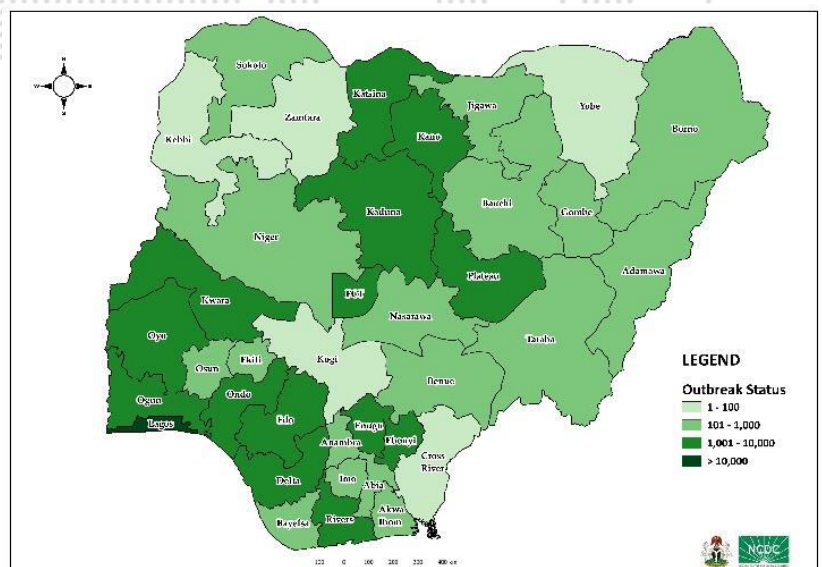
OVERVIEW OF WEEKLY COVID-19 NUMBERS
