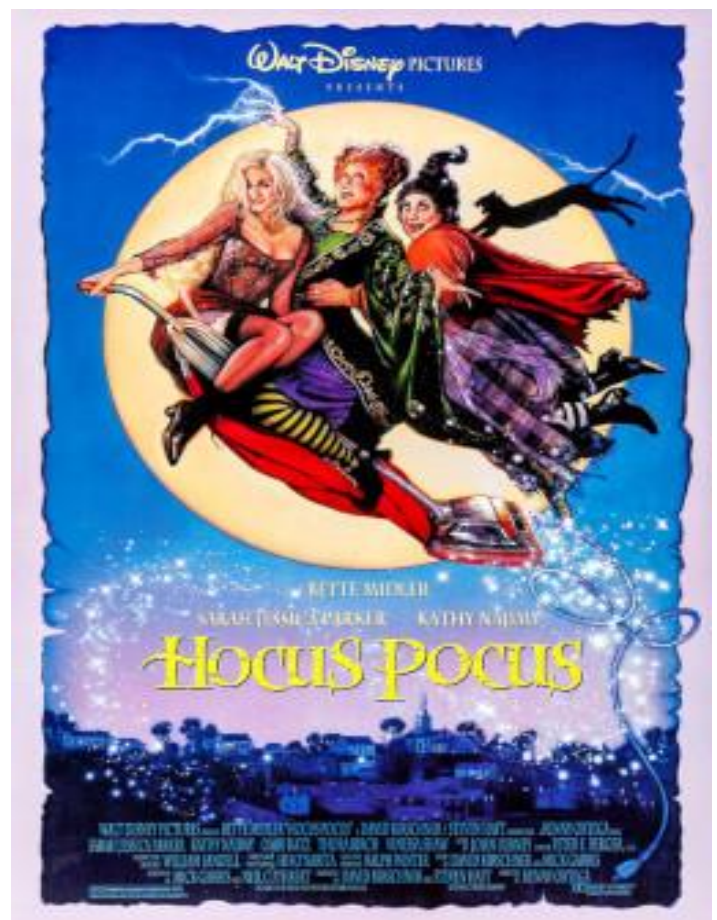
New News Continues

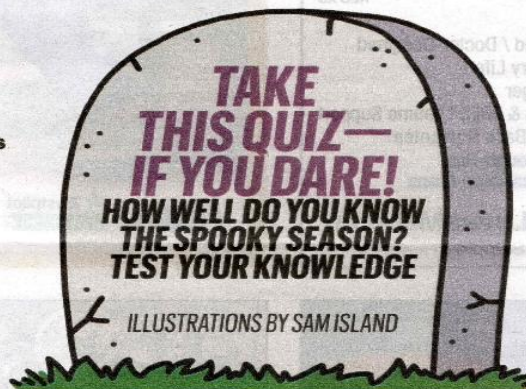

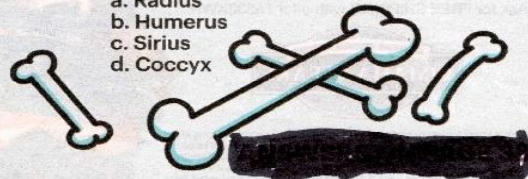
