The Qld Government's Department of Housing, and BSSC have signed a new Service Agreement for Specialist Homelessness Services, commencing 1 July 2023. This agreement is for 5 years.

BSSC has also been provided with additional funding to provide Immediate Housing Response for Families (IHRF) services for 2023/24.

HOUSING...

As we know, access to housing has become more difficult for many Queenslanders. You may be interested to have a look at the Qld Government's Department of Housing website (www.housing.qld.gov.au/) for more information about this issue.

The website includes information about services. The following information is copied directly from the 'Housing & Homelessness, Emergency Accommodation, Homelessness prevention' information...

'Homelessness can affect anyone—from single young people to families with children.

A staggering 20,000 people in Queensland are experiencing homelessness—this is 1 in every 200 Queenslanders (source, Australian Bureau of Statistics).

It can mean people who are sleeping rough, as well as people who are staying in temporary, unstable or substandard accommodation.

The reasons for homelessness are varied and complex including mental illness, domestic violence, relationship breakdowns, debt, substance abuse, housing affordability.

We fund over 100 non-government organisations to deliver more than 200 specialist homelessness services to help.'

Staff Member Profile – NATHAN CAPUANO


