Deputy Mayor Gustafson led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 pm.

Motion to approve the minutes of June 22nd, 2026, by Deputy Mayor Gustafson, seconded by Trustee Bates. All voting in favor, motion carried.

Motion to approve the minutes of July 13th, 2026, by Deputy Mayor Gustafson, seconded by Trustee Simko. All voting in favor, motion carried.

AUDIENCE

Pastor George, Deborah and George Burkinshaw of the Calvary Bible Baptist Church

Pastor Geroe Burkinshaw of the Calvary Bible Baptist Church came to the Board to read a statement he prepared about his application for the Jordan Fall Fest being denied. The Board responded by stating that we do not have control over the Jordan Community Council, they are the organization that makes those determinations, not the Village of Jordan Board of Trustees.

REGULAR MEETING

Clerk Trapp gave a report of Abstract #4 for a total of \$70,636.92; General \$45,234.17; Water \$4,644.83; Sewer \$3,889.19; Pool \$3,292.89; Trust & Agency \$12,989.97; Water Ban \$385.87 TE Erie Canal Celebration \$200.00. Trustee Bates motioned to approve Abstract #4 in the amount of \$70,636.92 and Deputy Mayor Gustafson seconded the motion. All voting in favor, motion carried.

REPORTS

Buildings and Grounds:

Trustee Simko announced that Elizabeth a 10th grader from JE School, is painting the canal boat that goes on the pavilion in Erie Park. Trustee Simko will need wood and supplies for the painting totaling about \$150.00

Trustee Simko has been looking into the picnic tables that will be replaced at the Erie Canal Park. There will be a metal handicap accessible picnic table, the others will be wood, all will be bolted to the concrete.

Trustee Simko reported that Zack in our DPW Dept has finished the roof on the shed, looks great!

Trustee Simko reported that the growth on the Southwest side of the canal wall has been cut back. Trustee Simko cut back the trees, brush, weeds etc. DPW removed all the debris.

Trustee Simko stated that the clock tower base has some damage. The damage probably happened from the vibration of the construction when they were working on the water lines.

Trustee Simko announced that she is working on the reconfiguration of the offices within the Village Hall. That project will be starting soon. She will be rearranging/sorting/organizing the rooms upstairs first, move offices around to make room for the Mayor's office upstairs, then work on enclosure for Clerk Trapp.

Water & Sewer:

Mayor Brim announced that he and Fred DiRiso are meeting with the Town of Brutus and Barton & Loguidice regarding the joint sewer project, whether or not to move forward.

Public Safety:

Nothing new at this time

Streets & Drainage:

Mayor Brim reported that Highlander will be ready to pour sidewalks soon on S. Main St. Mayor Brim reached out to Magnaflood to get an estimate for 5 lights for S. Main St. We are looking at around \$16,000, not including the electrician.

Mayor Brim General:

Mayor Brim announced that the Mayor Association summer outing is the Syracuse Mets game that is scheduled for August 18th, 2026, VIP seating and food will be provided cost is \$35.00 per Board member if wanting to attend.

Mayor Brim announced that the 6th Annual Celtic night will be held on August 5th, 2026, in the Memorial Park at 6:00 pm.

Mayor Brim announced that the LAX Club would like to donate money towards the new push mower since it is also being used for their area as well.

Mayor Brim reported that the spotlight bulb in the Veteran's Memorial Park was replaced, costing \$350.00.

Mayor Brim stated that a call to our alarm company is needed, we have had 3 false alarms recently.

Unfinished Business:

Proposal to repeal Local Law 2-2003 "A Local Law to amend the Village Zoning Law related to multi-family zoning districts"

New Business:

Mayor Brim requested the Board of Trustees to approve of the Joint Water Project Bond Resolution increase of \$600,000.00. Deputy Mayor Gustafson motioned to approve and seconded by Trustee Bates, all voting in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Brim requested the Board of Trustees to approve provisionally appointing Charles Laun to the Village of Jordan Zoning/Planning Board pending his response. Trustee Bates motioned to approve and seconded by Trustee Simko, all voting in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Brim requested the Board of Trustees to approve of Trustee Simko to reorganize, sort & file, then reconfiguration of the offices within the Village Hall. Trustee Bates motioned to approve and seconded by Deputy Mayor Gustafson, all voting in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Brim requested the Board of Trustees to approve of picnic tables for the Erie Canal Park not to exceed \$2,500.00 and two for the pool not to exceed \$500.00. Deputy Mayor Gustafson motioned to approve and seconded by Trustee Bates, all voting in favor, motion carried.

A motion to pay the bills and file the correspondence was made by Trustee Simko and seconded by Trustee Bates, all voting in favor, motion carried.

Motion offered by Deputy Mayor Gustafson and seconded by Trustee Bates to adjourn the meeting. All present voting in favor. Motion carried at 8:13 pm.
