#### **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY.**

This local law is enacted pursuant to the New York State Constitution and New York Municipal Home Rule Law §10.

#### **SECTION 2.** LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE & INTENT.

The purpose of this Local Law is to provide for additional requirements for one family detached dwellings within the Planned Development District known as Locktenders Landing.

## **SECTION 3.**

Subdivision 2 ("Any Structure") of Subsection A ("One Family Detached Dwelling") of Section III ("Lot and Structure Minimum Dimensional Requirements") of the Planned Development District Regulations (Locktenders Landing) is hereby amended by adding a new Paragraph e to read in its entirety as follows:

"e. Minimum Habitable Space:

- 600 square feet, first floor and 220 square feet, basement; or (i)
- 817 square feet, first floor

For the purposes of this paragraph, "habitable space" is as defined in the Uniform Code of New York State, meaning space in a building for living, sleeping, eating or cooking. Bathrooms, toilet rooms, closets, halls, storage or utility spaces and similar areas are not considered habitable spaces."

### **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the

clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

## **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Local Law shall take effect upon enactment by the Village of Jordan Board of Trustees and filing with the Office of the New York State Secretary of State.
