Mayor Brim General:

Mayor Brim reported the unveiling of the Vietnam Plaque in the Memorial Park will be done during the Fall Festival on Saturday, September 19th, 2026, at 11:00 am.

Mayor Brim announced that JE Superintendent Froio has reached out to Mayor Brim and our Codes Department regarding a request from NB&C to install an 88-foot-tall Verizon Cell Tower on the Middle School property. This was discussed amongst the Board members, and all are in agreement to write a letter of support.

Unfinished Business:

Proposal to repeal Local Law 2-2003 “A Local Law to amend the Village Zoning Law related to multi-family zoning districts”

New Business:

Mayor Brim requested the Board of Trustees to approve of the Winter Wander’s request for permission to have use of trail through the Village. Trustee Stapleton motioned to approve and seconded by Trustee Bates, all voting in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Brim requested the Board of Trustees to approve of SynergEV wanting to add 4 – 5 new DC Fast Charging Stations within the Village and will pay for all electricity and will share 5 – 10% gross revenue. Discussion has been tabled for now, all voting in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Brim requested the Board of Trustees to approve of hiring Alan Griffo as Assistant DPW Superintendent at \$25.00/hour beginning on August 31st, 2026. Trustee Bates motioned to approve and seconded by Deputy Mayor Gustafson, all voting in favor, motion carried.

A motion to pay the bills and file the correspondence was made by Trustee Simko and seconded by Trustee Bates, all voting in favor, motion carried.

Motion offered by Trustee Stapleton and seconded by Deputy Mayor Gustafson to adjourn the meeting. All present voting in favor. Motion carried at 7:40 pm.
