



Bob Burzynski Scholarship Information Sheet

AMPP Rocky Mountain Chapter provides scholarships to provide financial assistance for students attending accredited universities and colleges, preferably but not limited to studies in the field of engineering and science.

Who is Eligible?

1. The student must be an active member or related to a member of the AMPP Rocky Mountain Chapter (RMC) that is in good standing. Son, Daughter, Grandson, Granddaughter, Stepson, Stepdaughter.
 - a. Active member includes attendance of at least one AMPP RMC event per year and has been a member in good standing for a minimum of 6 months.
2. The student must be accepted to an accredited college/university preferably working toward a degree in Engineering or Sciences but not limited to the field of engineering and science.
3. The scholarship recipient must maintain FULL-TIME status at an accredited college/university.
4. The student must have and maintain a GPA of 2.75 or higher.

How to Apply

Applicants must submit all of the following material no later than January 13th, 2026.

1. A completed application signed by the student and a parent/guardian if the student is under the age of 18.
2. An official transcript from the student's high school or college/university.
3. An official letter of acceptance from the designated college/university.

Recipient Selection Process

1. The winners will be selected by an independent committee of members appointed by the AMPP Rocky Mountain Chapter Board of Directors.
2. The selection committee members may not be affiliated with scholarship candidates.
3. Scholarship winners are chosen based on performance in several categories including grade point average, scholarship need, work experience, honors received, volunteer, and extracurricular activities.

Scholarship Benefit

1. The number and amount of scholarships to be distributed may vary each year according to our current budget at the AMPP Rocky Mountain Short Course.
2. Scholarship recipients will receive reimbursements to assist with the cost of tuition, books and lab fees only.
3. Due to changes in the tax laws, the scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university designated on your scholarship application. Checks will be made to the college/university and the student.
4. Scholarships will be presented to the member, or related member of the AMPP Rocky Mountain Chapter at the 2026 AMPP RMC Short Course. If not present, they will be forwarded to the student via email by January 31st, 2026. A certificate will be provided redeemable for the promised scholarship amount at the request of the student.

Taxability

At the present time, scholarships under this plan are not taxable. If there is a change, recipients will be notified.
