- 3. If a Bible is held improperly, a penalty of ten points will be incurred.
- 4. A continuous infraction of the rules or unbecoming conduct will disqualify a contestant from further participation. The decision rests with the judges.
- 5. Bible Sword Drill is properly judged with a minimum of three judges.
- The timekeeper should use a regular stopwatch if available. A timepiece with a large second hand may be substituted when necessary.
- 7. The contestant with the highest number of points shall be declared the winner. The contestant with the second highest number of points shall be declared the runner-up. In the event of a tie, three additional items will be used in a tie-breaking drill. All rules apply as in the original drill.
