

3. If a Bible is held improperly, a penalty of ten points will be incurred.

4. A continuous infraction of the rules or unbecoming conduct will disqualify a contestant from further participation. The decision rests with the judges.

5. Bible Sword Drill is properly judged with a minimum of three judges.

6. The timekeeper should use a regular stopwatch if available. A timepiece with a large second hand may be substituted when necessary.

7. The contestant with the highest number of points shall be declared the winner. The contestant with the second highest number of points shall be declared the runner-up. In the event of a tie, three additional items will be used in a tie-breaking drill. All rules apply as in the original drill.
