

Hi Fur families...

I cannot believe that it's already the end of October?!

Its been a crazy, busy few months and now the silly season is well and truly upon us!

Recently we've welcomed new faces and sadly we've also seen some friends move away, but all in all we're having a blast!

The information below is just a wrap up of any current hot topics. Please contact me if any clarification is needed.



Council Rules and Regulations

It is a requirement of all local councils that your dog is not only microchipped, but also registered. This is the responsibility of the owner and we have recently seen fines issued for unregistered dogs.

All dogs must also wear an ID tag with their name and your contact details on it. This can be affixed to a collar or harness.

It is strongly advised that all dogs are desexed by 1yr. Undesexed dogs will absolutely attract more negative attention - over interest and aggression, and will generally also display more erratic behaviour themselves. It is an increased risk to them individually and to group dynamics. Whilst I do not automatically exclude undesexed dogs, if behaviour issues arise, they will be the first to go.



Walk Times

Summer walk times are always earlier than Winter to avoid the peak heat of the afternoon. These changes will commence in November and are as follows:

1st walk pick up: 8-8.30am 2nd walk pick up: 10-10.30am 3rd walk pick up: 12-12.30pm

Reminder that all walks are for 1hr. The overall duration of the time away from home depends on location and pick up/drop off order. It could be from 1hr 20mins to approx 2hrs.

Please remember dogs have little concept of time and will sleep a large portion of any day. This is why set times are rarely offered, only set days. Each day will vary due to personality type/size/location of dogs.





<u>Grooming</u>

As you're probably aware the bindis and prickles on the ground currently are pretty badddd!!

There are several different types, and they are present in varying degrees at all local parks at the moment.

Any portions of longer coat - tails/legs, or high contact areas belly/ears will always attract multiple prickles, and whilst I try and remove as many as I can post walk, it is impossible to get them all out in the limited time I have. So as annoying as it is, if you have active doggos, just remember regular brushing and shorter cuts will prevent matting.

Also in general we are an active group, so this means dirt, sand, water etc.. are an everyday occurrence!

I will always try and rinse off heavy dirt and towel dry as best I can, but expect some dirty paws often...sorry, not sorry

<u>Accounts</u>

Accounts are run weekly (unless negotiated otherwise). All accounts should be paid in full by Sunday. Invoices will be issued on Fridays to those accounts not already paid. For those accounts paid regularly via a standing payment, invoices will not be issued unless requested.

Please also be aware I am looking at a small price increase in 2024. I haven't changed my prices in sometime despite there being a sharp increase in cost of fuel/cost of living. There will be ample warning before anything comes into effect.



Hey Everyone!


Well here we are and it's already March?! How is it that we are 3 months into this new year, yet somehow it feels like only yesterday it was new year resolution time...



Accounts are run weekly (unless negotiated otherwise). All accounts should be paid in full by the Friday of each week. Invoices will be issued on Thursdays to those accounts not already paid. For those accounts paid regularly via a standing payment, invoices will not be issued unless requested.

Please remember it's easy to lose track of where you're up to, and at my end I simply cross check payments received against amounts owing. However I'm human and sometimes I can miss recording a payment, so please always let me know if you think your account is not accurate.






As you're definitely aware, the weather in recent months has been crazy!! We've had lots of sun and lots of rain, these things alone bring some health challenges - heat exhaustion, sunburn, viral gastro and lots of ant/bug bites

Just a reminder that if you do suspect your fur baby has an infectious disease like gastro or kennel cough, they should be excluded from group walks, until symptoms have resolved and veterinary treatment sought.

In regards to the heat, we lower our activity level

significantly on the days above 30 degree. We also hang out a lot in the shade and utilize water play in the form of the hose, paddle pools or beach/ponds.

Any bug bites are usually just an annoyance more than anything and respond well to a good rinse under the hose or a soak in the pool.

Important dates to remember!!

We will be taking a trip from April 15th - 23rd There will be no walks on these days. Please be mindful of any direct debits you have in place...



All walks are 1hr once at location + travel time. Your fur baby might be picked up first or last depending on the day and their location, so time away from home can be anything between 1hr 20mins and 2hrs.

Registration and name tags with your contact details on them are mandatory council requirements.

Desexing is strongly encouraged as non desexed dogs face more aggression from other dogs. They also tend to exhibit behaviour that annoys other dogs...humping, excessively guarding toys and food etc.
