<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Create a written list of ways that youth can participate and use their skills in each work group<input type="checkbox"/> Identify opportunities for youth participation in other CTC tasks, activities, and events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Identify local youth groups to engage; make this list as inclusive as possible (not just A-students or athletes, etc.)<input type="checkbox"/> Create a written plan to involve youth in CTC work groups, activities, and events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Develop materials targeted to youth, such as posters, social media graphics, promo items, etc.<input type="checkbox"/> Recruit youth for CTC involvement based on the ideas generated in the “Identify & Plan” section	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Solicit input from youth about all aspects of CTC, especially their ideas on the best ways to reach and continue recruiting youth<input type="checkbox"/> Solicit youth input on the Community Action Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Identify opportunities for youth to continue growing their skills in CTC (see the Social Development Strategy)<input type="checkbox"/> Provide training, support, and assistance to youth as needed to develop these skills
