



RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM

Surfing is a fun and healthy sport that promotes fitness, respect for the environment, and a healthy lifestyle. Water safety is a key aspect of surfing. DP Surf Coach will provide safety education and always strive to keep students safe on the beach and in the water.

I understand that surfing carries a degree of risk that no amount of care, caution, or instruction can fully eliminate. Hazards include, but are not limited to: falls, being struck by a surfboard or other equipment, collisions with other surfers, currents, riptides, marine life, rocks and reefs, sun exposure, and underlying health conditions.

I hereby release from liability DP Surf Coach, Lucas Taub, and any assistants, (hereafter the "released parties") from legal action, liabilities, or claims by myself or any representatives, third parties or heirs, for any injury, death, or loss occurring to myself, my minor, or my property while participating in, or traveling to or from any surf activity offered by the released parties, which may occur as a result of the released parties actions, a third party, animals or wildlife, nature, or the conditions of the beach, parking lot, and premises.

I voluntarily assume all risks of personal injury or loss of life or property which may occur while participating in, or traveling to or from, any surfing activities conducted by the released parties. I will not sue or bring legal action against the released parties and indemnify and hold harmless the released parties from all claims, judgments, and costs.

By signing below, I agree that this release of liability is binding and can only be changed in writing. I also certify that I, or the minor I am registering for the program, can swim and does not have medical conditions that prevent safe participation in surfing.

If signing for a minor, I hereby acknowledge by signing below, to be the lawful parent and/or guardian of the minor and I therefore acknowledge my qualifications to sign the agreement on their behalf.

In the event of an injury requiring immediate attention, lifeguards, if on duty, will be summoned. If lifeguards are not on duty and the injury appears serious, emergency medical services will be contacted. Parents or guardians, if not present, will be immediately notified. Therefore, for students who are minors, parental availability by phone during the activity is recommended.
