'Until Healing Comes' Support Groups

The GriefCare Place offers a progressive program of grief care through support groups provided without cost to the griever. It introduces those grieving the death of a loved one to the normal grieving/healing process in a sensitive and gentle way.

Until Healing Comes - for adults who have experienced any death; provides foundational information about normal, natural grief and is a safe, non-judgmental place to begin grief support with others who understand.

Passport to Healing - For those who have learned about grief and have completed their period of acute grieving (typically in their second year of grief). The goal of this group is to focus on integrating loss into life toward reaching a new purpose and full life.

Support Groups with a Specific Focus

Widowed Women - for women of any age who have experienced the death of a spouse.

Widowed Men - for men of any age who have experienced the death of a spouse.

Bereaved Parents - for parents who have experienced the death of a child of any age.

Other Adult Losses - for adults grieving the death of a parent, sibling, close friend or relative other than spouse or child

After Suicide - for adults who have experienced the death of a loved one through a completed suicide. (Temporarily suspended)

HALO - Hope After Loss to Overdose - for adults dealing with the death of a loved one due to drug overdose. (Temporarily suspended)

Kids' Time - for children 6 to 12 years of age; who are gently led in understanding death and grief. Led by a professional clinician.
