‘Until Healing Comes’ Support Groups

The GriefCare Place offers a progressive program of grief care through support groups provided without cost to the griever. It introduces those grieving the death of a loved one to the normal grieving/healing process in a sensitive and gentle way.

Until Healing Comes - for adults who have experienced any relational death; the goal of this group is to provide foundational information about normal, natural grief and to offer a safe, non-judgmental place to begin grief support with others who understand - under the guidance of trained facilitators. The focus of this group is to come together to educate, encourage and uplift one another through the healing journey.

The Rebuilding Series - The goal of this quarterly workshop series is for individuals who have moved beyond the initial stages of grief and are seeking to build their lives with hope, purpose, resilience and meaningful connections. Whether through guest speakers, panel discussions, or facilitated conversations the goal is to encourage participants as they continue moving forward through the sharing of practical tools, shared wisdom, and opportunities to connect with others who understand the unique challenges of moving through life after loss.

Prerequisite: *have attended 3 months of more of other GriefCare Place support group(s) and are in the second year of their grief journey or beyond.*

Support Groups with a Specific Focus

Widowed Women - for women of any age who have experienced the death of a spouse.

Widowed Men - for men of any age who have experienced the death of a spouse.

Bereaved Parents - for parents who have experienced the death of a child of any age.

After Suicide - for adults who have experienced the death of a loved one through a completed suicide.

Other Adult Losses - for adults grieving the death of a parent, sibling, close friend or relative other than spouse or child

In This Together - for children 6 to 12 years of age; who are gently led in understanding death and grief. Led by a licensed clinician.
