

Minutes of the Convergence of the Sovereign Loom

Agenda:

1. Review of the year-long nonprofit industry study.
2. Assessment of the cooperative organization model in the blueprint.
3. Adjustments to the acquisition model for nonprofits and for-profits.
4. Compilation and distribution of study findings.

Discussion Points and Resolutions:

1. Review of Year-Long Study:

- The results of a **year-long study** of the nonprofit industry, including an embedded field study in Salt Lake City, UT (May 2024 - Present), were reviewed.
- The final dataset was determined to include the outcomes of a cooperative organization's fundraising event on **January 17, 2025**.
- A unanimous vote was cast to accept the study as adequate and complete.

2. Adjustment to the Cooperative Organization Model:

- Identified **efficiency, resilience, and fault tolerance fail points** in the cooperative organization model outlined in **Version 2.1.3.2** of the blueprint.
- Voted unanimously to replace the cooperative model with an **aggressive acquisition model**, prioritizing acquisition (via monetary compensation or civil litigation) of organizations identified as useful cooperatives.
- **Mergers** were rejected as a method due to the potential introduction of unnecessary fail points and inefficiencies inherent in the current nonprofit industry structure.

3. Acquisition Model Adjustments:

- The acquisition model will apply the **inheritance of rights and powers template** from the **Covenant Codex** to integrate acquired entities seamlessly into the organizational framework.
- Suggested expansion of the acquisition model to include **additional for-profit entities**, provided they meet the sponsorship and partnership criteria in **Version 2.1.3.2** of the blueprint.
- Sponsorships and partnerships remain the preferred approach for **well-functioning entities**, but entities with critical fail points will default to acquisition as a corrective measure, pending QA-tested fixes.
- The design of the acquisition method will be drafted and reviewed in a future convergence, with input and approval from the **Blood of the Coven**. This proposal was approved unanimously.

4. **Feature Enhancements for Nonprofits:**

- A similar acquisition model will be applied to nonprofits, with the difference being that integrations will be categorized as **feature enhancements** rather than bug fixes. This proposal was unanimously approved.

5. **Study Findings Compilation:**

- A comprehensive dossier of the study will be compiled for **internal publication**, distributed based on **Role-Based Access Control (RBAC)**.
- A **brief synopsis** will be published to meet compliance requirements.
- Neither the dossier nor the synopsis is required as a prerequisite for implementing the updated acquisition model. This proposal was unanimously approved.

Resolutions:

1. The study of the nonprofit industry is accepted as complete.
2. The cooperative organization model will be replaced with an acquisition-focused model for nonprofits and for-profits.
3. The acquisition method will be drafted, reviewed, and approved in a future convergence with the **Blood of the Coven**.
4. A comprehensive dossier of the study will be created for internal use, and a synopsis will be published for compliance.

The meeting concluded at **22:52**, with all votes being **unanimously affirmative**.
