Burning rubber or excessive acceleration will absolutely not be tolerated. Violators will be removed from the parade immediately.
- Participants must maintain a forward motion at all times once the parade has begun.
- No on or off loading during the parade route.
- No vulgar or explicit music can be played during the parade. Music must be family friendly.
- FOTC reserves the right to refuse any participation for any reason they deem fit.
