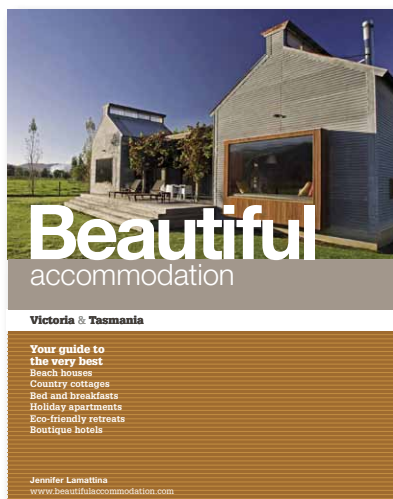

Beautifully furnished, spacious entertainer

Here is the ideal property for a group getaway or family reunion – it comfortably sleeps 12 people.

Isabelle Beach House is tucked away in a private oasis in Rye and just a 300m walk to the beach. It is an entertainer's delight, with everything you need for a memorable stay. Pool, Jacuzzi, oodles of space... It even has undercover parking for a boat.

There is an immaculately presented main house and separate bungalow, with beautiful furnishings and incredible attention to detail throughout. Not only does the main dining table seat 12, but the large kitchen also has all the crockery and platters to feed a houseful of guests.

The kitchen opens onto the main dining and living areas, which make up the hub of the house. Here you

can get the open fire started on cooler nights and relax in front of the LCD TV.

The house has three bedrooms, one with a wall-mounted LCD TV and walk-in robe, the second with a queen bed and the third with four bunks. Two bathrooms easily accommodate everyone's needs and a further living area includes a fabulous bar at one end and a massive *chaise longue* at the other.

The kids may wish to take over the separate bungalow, which sleeps four. It has a queen bed and two bunks, and its own air conditioner. Outdoors, the large pool should keep everyone happy in summer, while the covered setting and sun lounges allow for plenty of relaxing while keeping an eye on the action.
