Junior Golf Scholarships

Junior Golf Scholarships were awarded to 94 Lansing area teens for 2003. Over 1850 rounds were played this year, an average of over 20 rounds per player, at the four City of Lansing Golf Courses between Memorial and Labor Day. This is up from 1530 rounds in 2002. And did they play a lot?? One player said he played so much "that I had to re-grip my clubs."

Scholarship recipients get a Gold Pass that enables them to play 9 holes on three of the city courses for \$0.25 or \$1.25 at Grosbeck everyday during non-peak hours. The purpose of course is to enable kids to become fans of golf and learn the game at this early age as well as the social and etiquette side of the game.

Like every previous year, we got lots of thank you notes and letters. They used the pass to "spend valuable time with their family and friends" (must have been that five-some in front of me....!). Others said, "..it also helped me meet new people..." A mother wrote that the Scholarships "are number one on this mothers list of summer blessings...it had a very significant and positive impact on my son's lives." Another wrote that his average improved from 54 to 45 this summer. Several reported improving their scores enough to try out for (and several made) their high school golf teams. Another wrote "it helped her prepare for the girls golf (team) this (coming) spring. Many wrote they had "so much fun this summer" and "thank you for this opportunity...."

The Program is a joint effort of GLAGA, together with partners Lansing Youth Recreation Fund

GLAGA Tour Championship in 2004

New this year is a season-long points competition which will determine the "GLAGA Tour Champion." The Champions (Open and Senior Divisions) will be crowned after the seasonending GLAGA Tour Championship to be held September, 11 and 12. No Senior Tournament in 2004; New Senior Division in Every GLAGA Event

GLAGA has not scheduled a Senior Championship for 2004. Instead, every event will feature Open and a Senior Division. Members born before 1955 are eligible for Senior Division play, which is optional. Each contestant must designate a Division on the tournament entry form. In team events both players must have be born before 1955 to play in the Senior Division.

Open Division Semi-final and Finals matches and the Senior Division Finals matches will be contested on Monday, June 14.

(led by Kris Nicholoff) and the Lansing Golf Course Operations Division (led by Don Ballard). Don provides administrative support and day-to-day organization leadership. Kris Nicholoff's group provides about 40% of the funding, GLAGA provides the remainder.

Scholarship applications are passed out at area middle and high schools, as well as the Boys and Girls Club and Community Centers in the spring. Applicants write a brief essay of why they want the scholarship together with age, address and family income.

A scholarship awards ceremony is held at Foster Community Center in May, with lower income kids receiving full scholarships; those from higher income families receive partial scholarships. MSU Golf Coach Emeritus, Bruce Fossum provides an inspirational message on the etiquette and philosophy of golf to the kids and their parents, along with their Gold Golf Passes. Bruce also provides two free summer Clinics at Akers. GLAGA also sponsors a Junior Tournament at Grosbeck in July.

This Year, thanks to our members, partners and donors, GLAGA will again sponsor the program. If you have a son or daughter interested in golf, and who wants a chance to play often, keep an eye out for flyers this spring, or watch for an application on GLAGA's web site: www.GLAGA.org.


