Cunningham Claims First All City

It was closer than he had hoped, but Russ Cunningham held on to win his first All City Championship at Forest Akers Golf Courses in East Lansing. The DeWitt resident held a four-shot lead through 11 holes on Sunday until back-to-back double bogies erased his lead.

Cunningham rebounded from his mistakes to post a three-day total of 220 (71-71-78) and hang on to win by one shot over East Lansing's Tom Mase, who was playing in his first All City for almost 20 years. Aaron Scott, also of East Lansing, shot 223 (73-76-74) to finish third. Dave Kaufman and John Bowersox finished tied at fourth place with 225 totals.

Course. Nick Klaver closed with an impressive 68 (224 total) to edge John McGraw by two strokes in the First Flight. Shawn Floyd claimed third place with a 227 three-day total.

In the Second Flight Dan Kares' final round 74 and 236 total bettered Mitchell Harrison by one stroke. Bob Dunham finished another stroke behind for third place.

Tim Koivisto won the Third Flight with a 247 total, two shots clear of Sam Beplar. Matt Atanasoff finished third with 253 strokes.

**Cunningham
Runs Away With Tour
Championship Series;
Martin Comes from
Behind in Senior
Division**

Russ Cunningham started strong and never looked back to the claim the season-long GLAGA Tour Championship Series. Cunningham easily out-paced Nick Hurst and Smith Patterson and claimed the title with 2,500 points. Hurst amassed 1352.5 points with strong finishes in the All City and final Tour Championship event. Patterson trailed with 1,190 points.

Senior Division standout Jerry Blake built what seemed an insurmountable lead with two events remaining. Emergency surgery sidelined Blake for the All City Championships, and when he opted to bypass the season-ending Tour Championship for another event, he left the door open Steve Martin and Stu White to make up ground. Martin edged White with 1,725 points to 1,675. Blake finished third with 1,650 points.

GLAGA created the season-long Tour Championship in 2004, fashioned after the Ryder Cup points system, to build interest and reward members who play in all or a majority of the GLAGA events. Tour Championship Director Dave Seehase felt the inaugural year was successful and hopes the series will stimulate more interest in 2005.

Russ Cunningham had little trouble closing out his season with a one-under par two-day total of 143. Brandon Lovelady finished second, a distant 11 strokes back. Nick Hurst and Craig Chambers followed with 157 and 161 totals, respectively.

Steve Martin's 36-hole total of 158 bettered Bob Davis by three strokes. The win propelled Martin to top of the standings in the Tour Championship Series. Timber Ridge member Mike Scieszka finished in third place with a 165 total.





Match Play and Stroke Play.

The most recent Ryder Cup held outside Detroit this fall showcased match play and the drama that can unfold with this format. Rule two covers match play, while rule three refers to stroke play. I will attempt to point out a few instances where the two forms of play differ significantly. Playing a match is intense. The ebb and flow of the game, along with the finality of running out of holes makes every shot important.

I will assume that you know the difference in scoring for the two formats. Let's look at a few other differences between match and stroke play:

■ First of all, in stroke play you have a fellow competitor(s). In match play you either have one opponent or at most two opponents if you are playing a threesome or foursome game. In stroke play you compete against the entire field. In a match you play only against your opponent(s).

■ In stroke play you must hole out on every hole. This is not the case during a match. The next stroke, the hole, or the match can be conceded at any time. Once a concession is made, it cannot be refused or withdrawn.

■ If a player believes that a rules violation was committed by his opponent during the play of the hole that affects the outcome of the hole, he must make a claim before anyone tees off on the next hole or in the case of the last hole before all players have left the putting green. Failure to do so means the hole must stand as played, unless the opponent knowingly gave wrong information. This usually translates to "cheating". In that case that player will lose the match.

Penalties and procedures differ in match play. Let's cover a few (this is only a partial review):

■ Match play must be played in the correct order. On the tee, the player with the honor

plays first. If this is not done, the opponent may require the tee shot to be replayed in the correct order. The ball that is furthest from the hole determines the order of play for the rest of the hole. Again, the shot may be recalled if the opponent so chooses when there is a violation of this requirement.

■ In general, any breach of a rule that results in a two stroke penalty in stroke play will result in a loss of hole in match play. Examples would include playing a wrong ball, playing from a wrong place, or improving the stance or line of play. A notable exception to the above involves playing the tee shot from outside the teeing ground. In stroke play this results in a two stroke penalty and the shot must be played from within the teeing ground. In match play, the opponent decides whether or not the tee shot will be replayed and there is NO penalty in either case.

■ In match play there is no penalty for hitting another ball after a stroke when both balls are on the putting green. In a match, if your ball strikes your opponent or his equipment, you may play the ball as it lies, or replay the shot from the original spot at your discretion.

There are many more rule, penalty and procedural differences between stroke play and match play. However, the most significant differences involve the play of the game. In stroke play with a competitive field, making a nine on the first hole leaves the player with a real uphill battle for the rest of the round and even the tournament in multi-round events. In match play, while on your way to that big number you can simply concede the hole, gather your thoughts and win the next hole—you'll be right back to even.

G.L.A.G.A. runs the All City Match Play tournament each year in June. I encourage you to enter. I think that you will truly enjoy the unique challenges and excitement that match play offers.
