GLAGA'S NEW MAILING ADDRESS



The Golf Association of Michigan has named Russ Cunningham & Stacy Slobodnik-Stoll as the men's & women's Players of the Decade to honor golfers who have accomplished the most in the first part of this new century. The selection was based on **1)** the total Honor Roll points each had earned over the ten year period (2000-2009) and **2)** an evaluation of the Championships each had won over that period. And, finally, the Players of the Decade needed to have a consistent record of achievement over the entire decade.

Cunningham (DeWitt/Hawk Hollow) won six championships in the past 10 years: the GAM Mid-Amateur (2001, 2002, 2004), the GAM Championship (2002), and the Michigan Public Links Match Championship (2004, 2007). Russ also played in 2 U.S. Amateurs, 3 U.S.G.A. Mid-Am's, and 2 U.S.G.A. Publinx while making match play in 4 of the 7 events.

Slobodnik-Stoll (Haslett/MSU) won eight championships: GAM Women's Mid-Am (2009, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005) and the GAM Tournament of Club Champions (2009, 2007, 2004). She is in her 13th season as the Head Women's Golf Coach at Michigan State University and has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year twice during her tenure.

Ferris State University golfer, **Eric Lilliboe** won the 2009 All City Championship in an exciting finish. He got up and down for par on the last hole to edge Russ Cunningham and Jonathon Pauli by one shot. Lilliboe fired rounds of 75, 69, and 70 for a total of 214, while Cunningham shot 73, 71, 71 for a 215 and Pauli shot 74, 67, 74 for a 215 as well. Josh Burt and Patrick Wolcott finished in a tie for fourth at 222. Lilleboe played well all summer and continued rolling in the putts for the Ferris State University golf team while gaining medalist honors in 3 events and helping the team to 3 victories. Ferris State teammate and local standout Garrett Simons from Grand Ledge has finished in the top 20 in each of the 4 fall events while elevating Ferris to a top 15 national ranking in Div II. GLAGA wishes them both success this spring and on into the NCAA D II National Championship.
