Two of the student-athletes are continuing their education and playing careers at Eastern Michigan University, one is playing club golf at MSU and one has set his sights on the golf management program at Ferris State University.

DeWitt High graduates Alex Jones and Ryan Carey helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Division 2 state titles for coach Dave Koenigsnecht. Jones, the individual fifth-place finisher at the 2011 state meet, averaged 36.7 for nine holes and earned medalist honors at the East Lansing and St. Johns invitationals. In addition to his golf, Jones played varsity tennis for two years and carried a 3.65 grade point average. He is attending EMU on a golf scholarship, played four events last fall and earned a 3.85 GPA in his first semester of college.

A standout foursome of high school golfers comprises this year's class of recipients of the award named for the mother of former GLAGA president and 2002 Michigan Amateur Golfer of the Year Russ Cunningham.

Carey, honorable mention all-state for his performance on the course and all-academic honorable mention for his work in the classroom, also played two years of varsity hockey for the DeWitt/St. Johns team. He finished high school with a 3.9

### Tournament lineup includes “new-old” format for All-City

Out with the new and in with the old: that’s the way the 2012 All-City Championship will be conducted over the first weekend in August. Instead of designating your division classification at the time of registration, all entrants will have to **earn** their way into the Championship flight based on the lowest scores from the first two rounds.

The decision to revert back to the previous format should help keep all flights competitive and the pace of play moving at a reasonable clip. The first two rounds of this summer’s Championship will be played at Forest Akers East/West, with the Sunday Championship rounds at Eagle Eye/Hawk Hollow.

grade point average and is enrolled in the Professional Golf Management program at Ferris State.

Holt High graduate Brian Burt, a two-time first team all-state selection for coach Doug Harkema, is also a freshman member of the EMU golf team. Burt averaged 36.5 strokes per nine holes, won the CAAC Open and Division 1 district titles and finished first or second in 10 of 13 tournaments. Burt played three years of varsity tennis at Holt and maintained a 3.5 grade point average.

Kyle Sawyer played four years of varsity golf at Grand Ledge and helped the Comets qualify for the Division 1 state finals in three of those years. He was a Lansing State Journal first team all-area selection his junior and senior years and also was a four-year all-academic honoree. He completed his high school career with a 4.0 grade point average and was recognized in 2010 with a statewide award for sportswriting. Now a freshman at MSU, Sawyer is planning to major in either communications or journalism. He made the Dean’s List for the fall semester with another straight-A performance.

## Clark wins his second All-City Championship title

Nathan Clark of Charlotte broke par in all three rounds of the 2011 All-City Championship, including a final round of 71 at Eagle Eye, to claim his second Lansing tournament title by three shots over Blake English and Mark Foster.

Clark, who finished fourth in the 2010 All-City, carded a three-day total of 212 while English and Foster both finished at 215. Reid Dean and Tyler Polulak finished fourth and fifth, respectively, at 216 and 217.

"It's a great event," Clark told the Lansing State Journal. "It's obviously the biggest event in the Lansing area as far as a championship ... it's great to compete and have a chance to win it."

In the senior division, Mike Tungate won the Championship flight with a final round of 70 at Hawk Hollow. He finished with a three-day total of 214 (70-74-70), six strokes ahead of Mike Sequite (74-74-72). Craig Bidelman finished at 242 to win the senior division first flight while Jerry Laban won the second flight at 256. Jason Snider led the Championship first flight at 230, Greg Hills was best in the second flight at 245 and Chris Trudeau paced the third flight at 251.

Mara Kovac won the women's division with a three-day total of 232, which included a final round 81 at Eagle Eye.

Robert Matthiessen won the Spring Medal Play Open division title at The Emerald by one stroke, 146 to 147, over Tony Keim. A trio of players – Jeff Makley, David Brownback and Nathan Gunthorpe – finished at 148. In the senior division, Mike Sequite (152) edged Carey Mitchelson (155) and Mike Tungate (155). Brian Burt defeated Nathan Clark, 4 and 3, to win the Jersey Giant Mid-Michigan Match Play at Groesbeck and the twosome of Brian Pauli and Nick Hurst won the Buddy Buster at Royal Scot with a score of 142.
