
## **MARY JO TOMAC** SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

he completed with a 3.5 grade point average – Chris received the 69th House Citizen Award from Rep. Mark Meadows.

Casey Harkema played three years of varsity golf for the Rams and earned all-conference, all-area and academic honors each year. She helped lead the Rams to three consecutive regional championships and a third-place finish at state her junior year. A member of the National Honors Society and Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Casey graduated with a 3.9 GPA and is now attending Calvin College, where she is majoring in engineering. Her collegiate career is off to a strong start with the Knights, who finished third in the MIAA Championship last October.

Another Holt grad – Trent Tuttle – highlighted his senior season by winning three straight tournaments: the Lakeview Invitational in Battle Creek, with a 74; the Tullymore Invitational in Stanwood with a 3-under-par 68; and a CAAC Blue Jamboree at Arbor Hills in Jackson with a 1-under-par 35. Trent finished the year with the lowest scoring average (37.5 for 9 holes) in the Lansing area. He has since moved on to Hampden-Sydney College in Farmville, Va., where he is studying economics and also a member of the golf team. He played in two of the team's five tournaments this past fall.

Haley Blumer played three years of varsity golf at Grand Ledge for coach Tom Lindemann, PGA professional at Hawk Hollow and Eagle Eye. She earned All Area first team and All State Academic honors for her performance on the course and in the classroom, qualified for the Division 1 state finals and was named most valuable player for the Comets this past fall. She currently carries a 3.72 GPA, works as a dietary aide at Ingham Regional Assisted Living, is a member of the National Honor Society and plans to attend Grand Valley State to study occupational therapy.



## Castellani Survives Spartan Showdown To Win All-City Title

The 2012 All-City Championship came down to three holes between three Spartans, on the third and final day of the tournament. And when the last putt had been holed out at Hawk Hollow, Carson Castellani – an Okemos High grad now in his third year on the Michigan State golf team – had captured his first Greater Lansing Amateur Golf Association title.

Castellani captured top honors by shooting three straight rounds under par (67-69-70) for a winning total of 10-under, three shots better than defending champion and former MSU golfer Nathan Clark. The third member of the final group – Chris Mory, who had just completed his Spartan career – finished five back at 211.

"It's nice to win a home tournament where you know all the people, and it's fun to beat your friends," Castellani told the Lansing State Journal. "I was wearing down the last few holes. I hadn't had a lot of good results this summer, so I wanted to play well ... to hit the ground running into the college season with something a little more positive."

In the Senior Division, Jerry Blake overcame a six-shot deficit to force a playoff with Mike Tungate. It was a birdie by Blake on the second extra hole that sealed the victory, his third career Senior All-City title. Blake carded rounds of 66-78-72 while Tungate shot 65-73-78.

The following players also won All-City titles in 2012: Dugan Murphy (1st flight, 223 total); Matt Wait (2nd flight, 230); Rex Foster (3rd flight, 239); Michael Martinez (4th flight, 246); Erik Briggs (5th flight, 252); Larry Wuetrich (Senior 1st flight, 235); and Tom DePottyondy (Senior 2nd flight, 247, won in playoff).

Russ Cunningham shot rounds of 70 and 71 to win the Spring Medal title by two shots over Nathan Clark at The Emerald, while Alex Jones was three shots off the pace at 144. In the Senior Division, Mike Raymond carded a two-day total of 141 to defeat Randy Mastin and Larry Meirndorf by six shots. Andrew Brace defeated Carson Castellani 3 and 1 to win the Championship flight of the Jersey Giant Match Play at Groesbeck Golf Course while Randy Mastin defeated Jim Jakubowski on the 19th hole to win the Senior Match Play title.

The two-man team of Tommy Gut and Chris Beltzer won the Buddy Buster title at Royal Scot with a combined score of 146. In the Rehmann Classic Best Ball at Eldorado, the twosome of Hinkle/Davis took down top honors with a 27hole score of 97.
