

Newly renamed Fossum Scholarship rewards six high school student-athletes

Had he been at Eagle Eye Golf Club to see the 10th annual GLAGA Charity Classic, longtime Michigan State University men's golf coach Bruce Fossum would have been quite proud of the hearty band of nine foursomes that teed off on a blustery April 19 morning – and even moreso of the winning 9-under-par 133 carded by the team of Frank Comito, Gary Rymiszewski, Fred Djurdjev and Ted Brickey.

Last year the GLAGA board renamed its annual scholarship after Fossum, who passed away in March 2014 at the age of 86. MSU participated in 11 NCAA Championships — five times as a team, along with six individuals — and produced 10 All Americans during Fossum's 25 seasons. Fossum began the first college summer program for youth golfers in 1971, then served as the chairman of the NCAA Golf Committee from 1971-75 and as president of the Golf Coaches Association of America from 1977-79.

Bruce's wife Mary and his children – including his son Bob, 3-time All City champion – were on hand after the final round of the Championship Division to participate in the award presentations at Hawk Hollow to David Elzinga, Brent Marshall, Steven Wu, Shannon McNamara, Cody White and Kyle Harkema. Here is an update on the 2014 scholarship winners:

David Elzinga (DeWitt): I am attending Lansing Community College through the summer semester, and will be transferring to Wichita State University in Wichita, Kansas, in August. I will continue to study aerospace engineering. The best golf tip I ever received was from my high school (St. Johns) coach Paul Sternburgh who said, "You know you competed well when you're mentally tired after a round. Every shot is thought about before and after, that's what makes you better."

Kyle Harkema (Lansing/Holt HS): I am attending Calvin College and studying engineering.

Brent Marshall (Rives Junction/Lansing Catholic): I am an accounting major at Grand Valley State and a member of the

GVSU men's golf team. This summer I will be working at Hawk Hollow and Eagle Eye and playing in summer tournaments to keep my golf game competitive.

Shannon McNamara (Mason): I attend Wayne State University and am currently studying journalism and competing on the golf team. I will continue to work at Eldorado this summer as a cart washer and cart girl while also playing as much as I can. The best golf tip I have received so far is to read the book, "Golf is Not a Game of Perfect," written by Rob Rotella.

Cody White (DeWitt): I am attending Michigan State University and studying accounting and finance, and will be working at Forest Akers this summer.

Steven Wu (Okemos): I am currently attending New York University, majoring in Sports Management with a minor in the Business of Entertainment, Media and Technology at the Stern School of Business. I am not competing on a golf team right now but will try to walk on to the NYU team this coming fall. I will be interning at Forest Akers this summer to learn more about event and operations management, while also helping out with summer golf classes as well. My favorite golf tip is from my high school coach Dan Stolz who said, "Believe and trust that you can execute each shot. He inspired me to take that and apply it to my everyday life as well, which has helped my growth and development as a young adult."

GLAGA 2014 Season Recap

Castellani joins elite group as 3-time All City winner

The fast-moving Carson Castellani juggernaut climbed another notch in 2014 with his record third straight Player's Choice All City title, but not before cagey veteran Bob Matthiesen delayed the victory celebration by one playoff hole at Hawk Hollow.

Matthiesen's 4-under-par 68 gobbled up eight shots on Castellani in 18 holes and knotted their three-round totals at 4-under 212. Castellani answered the challenge quickly, nevertheless, with a birdie to end the sudden-death playoff in three strokes.

According to a story published by the Lansing State Journal, records dating back to 1926 show that no player has won the All City event three straight times. Gary Domagalski, Jack Pitts, Bob Fossum and Bob Mase all have three titles to their credit – just not in consecutive years. According to his Greater Lansing Hall of Fame induction plaque, Bud Reniger won the event five times.

"Whatever the history is, I'm glad I'm part of it," Castellani told the State Journal. "It's fun for me and fun for my family and everyone who has supported me for so long — my coaches, all the people in the community, friends who have played in this tournament who want to see me succeed. It means a lot to me to do well. I'm very happy my dad was here and caddied for me."

Castellani, who completed his eligibility with Michigan State's men's team last spring, owned a five-stroke lead over Blake English and seven shots over Brian Burt and 2011 winner Nate Clark going into the third round.

"It was a bit of a struggle today," Castellani told the Lansing State Journal. "And I kept saying to my dad, 'I just need one good thing to happen — make one putt, get up and down one time.' But it just never really happened (in regulation). I played OK, didn't have too good of control, and didn't make any putts, so I did well just to hang in there."

"That's the moral of the story. It's why you play hard on Friday and Saturday and get ahead by as much as you can."

Matthiesen played the front nine in even par before making birdie on No. 13, eagle at the par-5 15th and another birdie at No. 16. He would have won his second All City Championship (he won in 2000) if his birdie putt on the 54th hole had dropped.

"The way (Carson) has played has just been pretty cool to see," Matthiesen said. "I think it has really turned on a lot of the younger kids. More of the high school and college players are coming out now, and I think Carson has a lot to do with that. It's not quite as easy to come out here now and I think they (younger players) like that challenge."

Chris Beltzer shot a final-round 68 to leap into a tie for third with English at even-par 216. Mike Sequite won the Senior Division championship with a 54-hole total of 217.

Highlights from other

2014 GLAGA events included:

Spring Medal (The Emerald): Former Michigan State Spartan Nate Gunthorpe won the Championship flight by three strokes, 147-150, over another fellow Spartan, Nate Clark. Jonathan Pauli and Nate's brother, Nick Gunthorpe, finished third and fourth at 152 and 153, respectively. In the Senior Championship, Michigan Golf Hall of Famer and 2014 GAM Senior Men's Player of the Year Randy Lewis fired a two-day total of 146 to defeat runner-up Randy Mastin by 10.

Jersey Giant Mid-Michigan Match Play (Groesbeck): Oakland University sophomore Jacob Johnson defeated Aaron Miles, 4 and 3, to win the Open Division Championship flight while Gray Tuttle defeated Smith Patterson, 1 up, to win the Senior Division Championship flight. Gray's son, Trent Tuttle, won the Open Division first flight; Larry Meirndorf won the Senior Division first flight.

Buddy Buster (Royal Scot): The twosome of Frank Comito and Gary Rymiszewski proved best by two strokes, 141-143, over the team of Dave Lee and Bob Matthiesen. Tony Keim and Dale Choma finished third at 144 in the 27-hole event.

Team Match Play (Hawk Hollow-Eagle Eye): The team of Bob Matthiesen and Aaron Miles defeated Randy Mastin and Larry Meirndorf, 4 and 3, to win the Open Division championship while Tim Hovey and Mark Stein won the first flight title.






