FENTANYL FACTS

Information From DEA

Fentanyl is highly addictive, **50 times stronger** than heroin, and an incredibly small amount can kill you.

According to the CDC, a **leading cause of death** for Americans 18–45 is **drug overdose and poisoning**.

Fentanyl causes more deaths than COVID-19, gun violence, suicide, or car accidents.

107,622 Americans died from taking drugs last year. **66%** of those deaths were caused by fentanyl.

Many of the people who died from fentanyl had no idea they had even taken it. That is why we call those deaths poisonings and not overdoses.

It only takes a very small dose of fentanyl – **just two milligrams** – to be lethal, such as the amount found on the tip of a pencil.

According to DEA laboratory testing, on average a fentanyl pill contains **2.34 milligrams** of fentanyl.

Six out of ten pills tested in 2022 at DEA laboratories contain a potentially deadly dose of fentanyl. This is an increase from 2021, when four out of ten fake pills tested contained a potentially deadly dose of fentanyl.

Many of the people who died from fentanyl had no idea they had even taken it. That is why we call those deaths poisonings and not overdoses.



Fentanyl in every color, shape or form should be considered extremely dangerous and potentially deadly.

Lab testing indicates that color is **not** an indicator of potency.

Colored fentanyl is a marketing tactic used by dealers to increase sales.

Synthetic opioids, such as fentanyl, remain the primary driver of the opioid epidemic, with fentanyl involved in almost **70%** of drug poisonings.

Two criminal drug networks, the Sinaloa Cartel and CJNG, are primarily responsible for trafficking the fentanyl found throughout the United States.

Precursor chemicals primarily sourced from China are used by the Sinaloa Cartel and CNJG Cartel in Mexico to make the illicit fentanyl trafficked throughout the United States.

Anyone active on social media has the potential to encounter illegal drug sales online.

No legitimate prescription pill can be purchased on social media!
