Fentanyl is a highly potent synthetic opioid, 50 times stronger than heroin. Just 2 milligrams of fentanyl can be **lethal**, contributing to over 70,000 deaths annually in the U.S. Illegally made fentanyl is often mixed with other drugs or pressed into counterfeit pills, making it hard to detect and increasing the risk of fentanyl poisoning. This highlights the urgent need for community awareness, education on its dangers, and preventive measures like naloxone availability.

Your Life at Risk: The Hidden Danger of Fake Pills



Pills are so normalized in our society that they don't seem scary. But it's almost impossible to tell a real prescription pill from a fake one with deadly fentanyl. Fake pills are made to look like Oxycodone, Xanax, Adderall, and other meds. They're made with powders, binders, and often fentanyl to create addiction and ensure repeat business, making them very dangerous.

Remember, **ONE PILL CAN KILL!**

DEA lab testing reveals that **7** out of every **10** fake pills with fentanyl contain a potentially lethal dose.

LETHAL DOSE

It only takes a very small amount of fentanyl (2 milligrams) to be lethal.



In 2022, an average of 22 teenagers passed away from fentanyl poisoning **EACH WEEK** in the United States.

FENTANYL IS A GAME CHANGER! It is urgent that **EVERYONE** be educated about the risks and have strategies to keep themselves and their friends safe!
