It shall be the deliberative and assisting body in the formulation of the administrative plans and policies affecting the International Convention, including gifts, if any, for the International Family, District Governors, And First and Second Vice District Governors, Hospitality Rooms, Floats, Caucus Rooms, Gifts for Hospitality Rooms: etc., and any other expenses the WV PDGA deem necessary. It shall designate a depository for the International Convention Fund and approve the surety bond for the Treasurer. It shall demand and approve from the Treasurer financial reports, semi-annually or more audit at the end of the fiscal year of the books and accounts of business meetings as it deems necessary. It may establish its own policies and procedures, which shall be included in the MD 29 Policy Manual.
