WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT...

SCHOOL SEN COMPLAINTS

All schools must have a complaints procedure. This should be on the school website.

To complain about **SEN support**, you should do it while your **child is still registered** at the school.

This **includes** complaints that a school has **not provided** the **support** stated in an **EHCP**.

Check if the school has an **SEN Information Report**. It should explain how to **complain** to them about **SEN provision**.

If this does not resolve the problem <u>complain to the ESFA</u>* for academies & free schools & DfE* for any other school

DfE can't change a decision, but they can look at how it was made & ask a school to take action where appropriate.
