### **Veterans Memorial Update**

We are happy to let everyone know that our plans for maintenance at the Veterans Memorial of Orange Park continue to move forward. We have received an update on the status of delivery of the marble bench seat that was damaged by vandalism on June 10. The current estimated date of arrival is August 30 and it will be installed as soon as possible after it is delivered to the memorial. The Town of Orange Park and Jacksonville Memory Gardens are doing all they can to resolve this awful attack on the memorial.



The project to replace the existing pavers at the memorial continues. An order for Phase One consisting of 280 pavers was submitted on July 30. The pavers are expected to be delivered in late September. Our goal is to have them installed in October and ready in time for the Veterans Day Ceremony to be held on November 11, 2022.

### **Veterans Memorial Essay Contest**

All Clay County students in grades 4 – 12 are invited to participate in the Historical Society’s annual Veterans Day Essay Contest. As in previous years, students are invited to submit an essay on a veteran-related topic.

The topics are as follows:

<u>Grade Level</u>	<u>Word Limits:</u>	<u>Prize Offered</u>	<u>Prompt</u>
4th –6th	300-500	\$50	Why are veterans special?
7th –8th	400-700	\$75	Write about an American who served in the United States military who inspires you.
9th -12th	500-1000	\$100	Why are the words “Duty, Honor, Country” important today?

Essays must be received no later than September 30, 2022. The student submitting the winning essay in each category will receive a cash prize and be invited to present their essay at the Veterans Day Ceremony, 11 AM, Friday, November 11 at the Veterans Memorial in Magnolia Cemetery.




### **Images of America - Orange Park**
