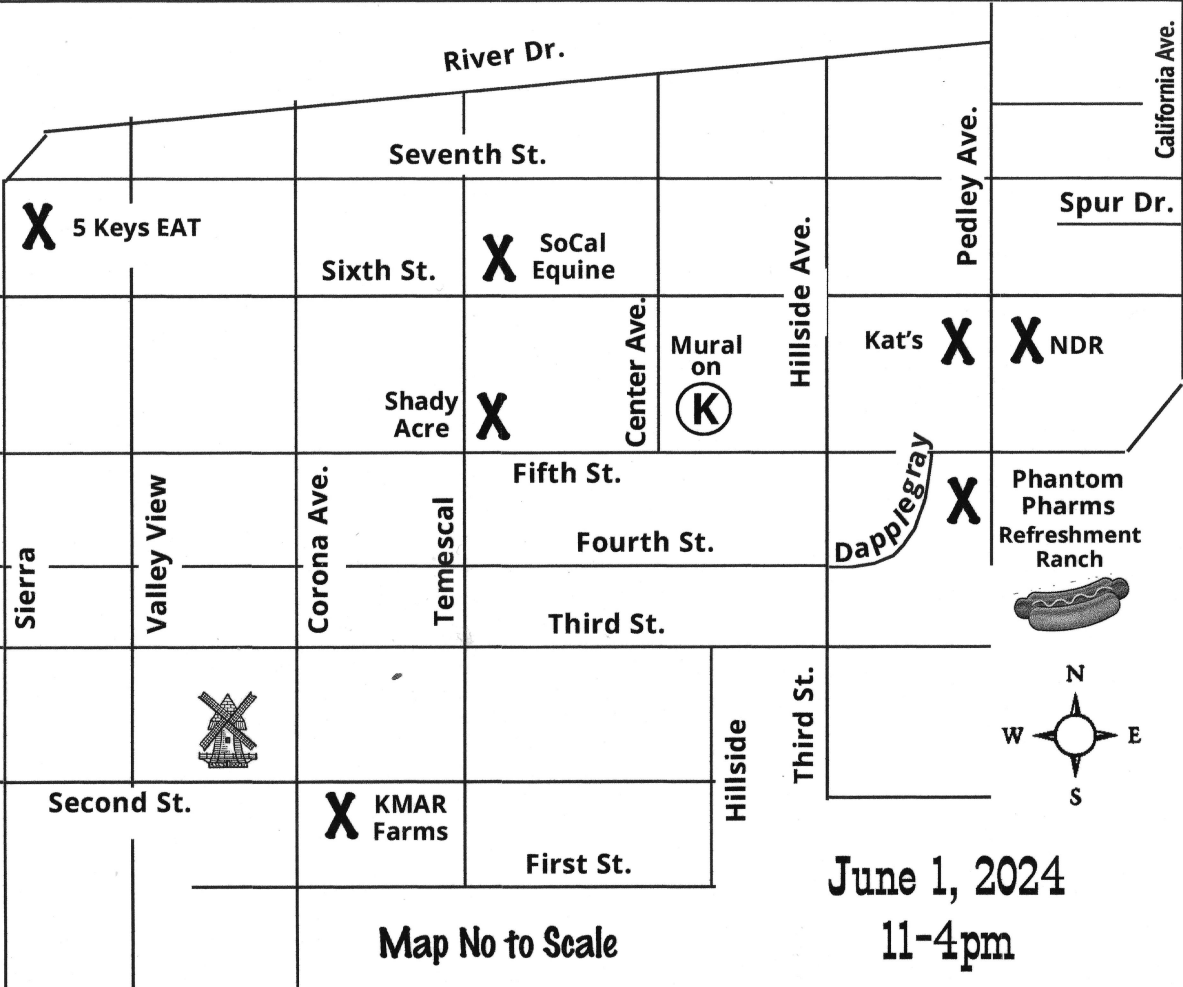

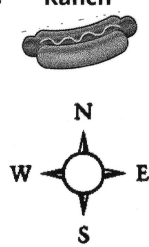

Shady Acre was started by two "city folks" in 1973. Over the last 50 years, Wayne & Elaine Lindsey have developed their acre into a farm that focuses on small-scale agricultural production. The primary focus is poultry and egg production, but the farm also features a small goat herd, garden boxes, citrus trees, and berries. A recent renaissance of small-plot agriculture has inspired Shady Acre to work on local licensing and certifications. A treat station along the goat pen and flower beds that serve as a monarch way station have made the Shady Acre a popular stop for folks in the neighborhood on their evening walks.
