

Summary of By Law changes for Dec 8 vote and approval by membership.

The Cherry Creek Board of Directors assigned a committee to recommend changes to update the CCSG By- Laws to account for the significant membership growth over the last 15 years, and how it needs to operate today vs 15 years ago. A summary the major changes are noted below. The new proposed bylaws are available for any members that would like to read them.

1. Cleans up language that better defines role of President and role of Board Chairperson.
2. Changes the number of Board of Directors from a minimum of 4 to 7, which represent the number of current board members needed to conduct today's business.
3. Voting privileges for new club members becomes effective 30 days after joining the club.
4. Changes a quorum to vote on club business from 10% of membership present, to 15 members in good standing and 3 officers present.
5. Clarifies the actual dates and times that meetings and elections take place.
6. Eliminates election proxies and clarifies # of votes families get (2) vs single adults (1).
7. Better defines how alternate board members are appointed and vote.
8. Defines when meetings can be held remotely via conference call.
9. Better defines the role of some officers and adds Safety Officer as a new officer position.

The Board approves and recommends the CCSG membership approves and adopts these revised bylaws effective Dec 8, 2021.
