





When minimizing transfers is your goal, planning your Alaska vacation around a base camp is the answer. The idea is simple. Instead of planning overnights at several different destinations, pick just one as home base. Take day trips from there and return to the same lodging each evening. If you have the time, connect two or more base camps for a longer stay in Alaska. Here are a few ideas to get you started.

BASE CAMP: SEWARD

Tidewater glaciers and marine wildlife star in Seward. Kenai Fjords National Park is your playground, accessible by day cruise, kayaking, and even guided hikes. Seward is also relatively easy to get around without a car, so if you'd prefer to travel by the Alaska Railroad or Park Connection Motorcoach, Seward works perfectly.

GLACIER ROUTE CRUISES

Seven-day Glacier Route Cruises that travel between Vancouver and either Seward or Whittier are highly recommended. Because they travel one way, you can easily add an accompanying land package to visit popular places like Denali National Park and Fairbanks. Cruise highlights include Glacier Bay National Park, Hubbard Glacier or College Fjord in Prince William Sound, and colorful port towns like Skagway, Juneau, and Ketchikan.

INSIDE PASSAGE CRUISES

Inside Passage Cruises typically sail on seven-day itineraries roundtrip from Seattle or Vancouver. These sailings travel mostly through the Inside Passage in Southeast Alaska. They're a nice introduction to Alaska cruising. However, we usually recommend Glacier Route Cruises, not only to see more of Alaska's dramatic fjords and glaciers, but for the chance to explore by land before or after your cruise.

Alaska Railroad Adventure Class

Adventure Class is the Alaska Railroad's standard service. Travel in a single level car with high ceilings and picture windows. Tour highlights provided by Alaska Railroad guides. Dining and bar service are available on the Denali Star and Coastal Classic rail routes. More limited "grab and go" dining options are available on the Glacier Discovery rail route.



Alaska Railroad Goldstar Dome

Goldstar is the Alaska Railroad's premium, two-level dome service. Upper dome seating features full length curved windows and bar service along with an outdoor platform. The

lower level features a full-service dining room. Meals and beverages are included.



The Wilderness Express

The Wilderness Express is the newest private dome rail service in Alaska. Luxurious cars feature an upper level glass dome and reclining leather seats. The lower level has

an outdoor vestibule and a dining room serving gourmet Alaskan specialties. The Wilderness Express travels on the Denali Star schedule between Anchorage and Fairbanks.



The McKinley Explorer

The McKinley Explorer is a premium dome service operated by Holland America-Princess. It features upper level dome seating, a lower level restaurant, and

outdoor vestibule. It operates a unique schedule between Anchorage, Talkeetna, and Denali.

ALASKA RAIL ROUTES & SCHEDULES

The Alaska Railroad offers three routes spanning over 470 miles with daily scheduled service from mid-May to mid-September to eight different Alaskan communities.

Denali Star Anchorage - Talkeetna - Denali Park - Fairbanks

The Denali Star travels 350 miles on a daily service between Anchorage and Fairbanks with stops in Talkeetna and Denali. Much of the route parallels the border of Denali National Park and the Alaska Range. Service choices of Adventure Class, Goldstar, or Wilderness Express.
