

AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 2026, by and between the **City of Celina**, an un-chartered municipality, 225 N Main Street, Celina, Ohio 45822 (hereinafter "City") and the Celina City Schools 585 E. Livingston St. Celina, Ohio 45822(hereinafter "Celina Schools").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City operates, manages and controls full-time emergency response squads, with responders trained in firefighting, emergency medical treatment and rescue operation; and

WHEREAS, the Celina Schools is in need of on-site stand-by services of an ambulance in case of an emergency during certain School events throughout the year, as mutually agreed between the School and the City.

WHEREAS, at these events, both parties agree it would benefit from the presence of trained responders, an ambulance; and

WHEREAS, additional on-duty responders will be needed to fulfill the needs of the Celina Schools at direct cost of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Celina Schools is willing to reimburse the City for its costs to have trained responders assigned to be present at the described events.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises hereinafter contained, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Fire Chief shall schedule and assign trained responders as needed to be present on-site at the Celina Schools events (as described above), as mutually agreed between the School and the City.
2. The responders shall report on station for duty and once assigned to the event, report in with Celina Schools designated representative.
3. The City shall supply an ambulance and responders, to facilitate their assigned duties on-site of the Celina Schools event.
4. The Celina Schools shall reimburse the City for the cost of assigning responders at the employee rate per current employee and City of Celina contract including fringe benefits payable to the Celina Fire Department.
5. To minimize costs to the school, responder coverage positions should be filled by qualified part-time personnel whenever possible. If adequate coverage cannot be secured through part-time personnel, full-time personnel may then be utilized to fill any remaining staffing needs.

6. A maximum of two personnel will be assigned for responder coverage at any given time. If circumstances require additional resources beyond the assigned responder coverage, personnel can be deployed from the station as needed at no additional cost to the school.
7. At no time shall the responders be considered employed by the Celina Schools. They will perform their duties under the command of the Celina Fire Chief.
8. It is understood and agreed that there may arise an occasion where the assigned responders must leave the site of the special event to assist other responders in an emergency situation. The School will not be charged for any time a responder is absent from the special event site.
