How To Play:

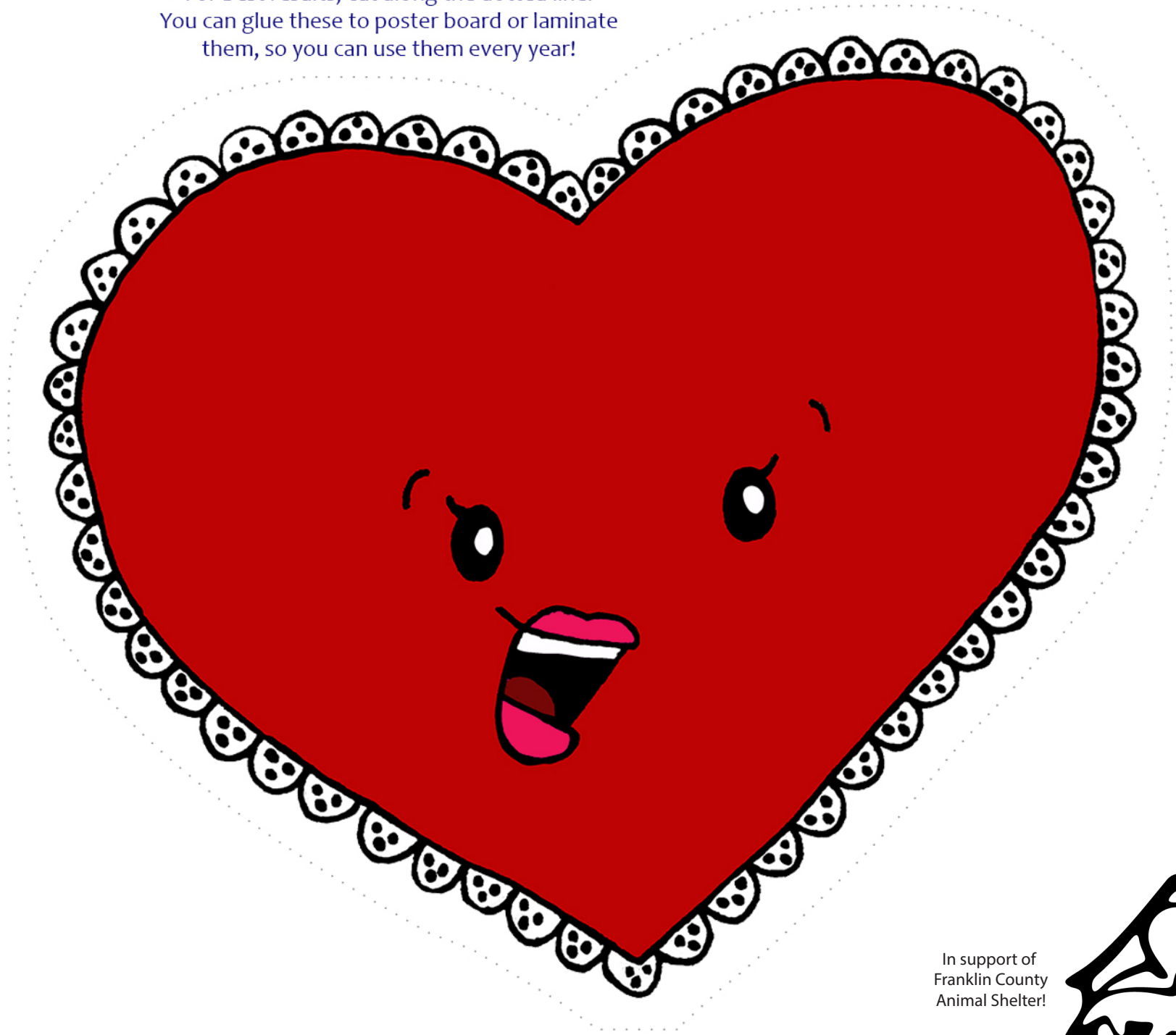
- ♥ **Print out all of the Pages, then cut the Characters out, using the Dotted lines as a guide. Some Pages may have special instructions, so read carefully!**

- ♥ **Once they are all hidden, everyone else may work as a team to find all of the missing items! It can Be a team of one, or a whole Classroom of People. It can Be Different every time, and we love to hear about the rules you have made up yourself!**
