Logline:

Ptoni the Pteranodon.

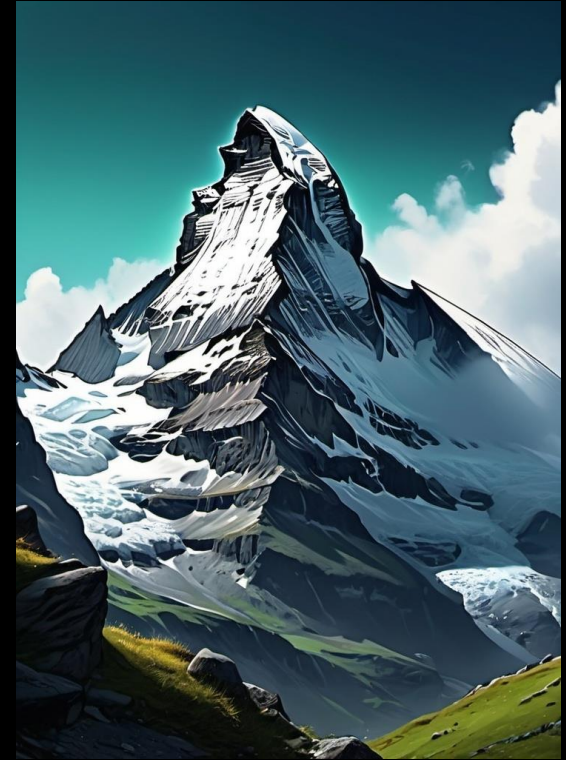
