The canal has access to Alligator Creek, which gives access to Charlotte Harbor, then proceeds to the Gulf of Mexico via the Boca Grande Pass. This waterway isn't just for boating, but plenty of fishing and crabbing right from where you stand on the backyard dock. Once it gets dark, be sure to check out the underwater fish light and watch for a variety of fish species – the main types include juvenile tarpon, snook, and saltwater catfish.

HOUSE RULES

Access In/Out

- Rental access time: 4:00 PM EST.
- Rental departure time (checkout): 11:00 AM EST.

UTILITIES

- This house utilizes a septic system. For bathroom sewage, do not flush personal products down the toilets.
- This home is equipped with an on-demand hot water heater. Due to the length of water pipes, it may take some time for the water to heat up (approximately one minute).
- Air conditioning control is mounted in the hallway and auto set for AC.
 Utilize your personal preference, but please note that the locked range is set between 74 and 78 degrees.
- This home is equipped with solar panels the Florida sunshine powers your stay!
- There are two Wi-Fi scanners one mounted in the entryway, and one positioned on the breakfast bar. Place your phone near the scanner, and the wi-fi password will be provided.
- Both doors are equipped with smart locks and keypads. To unlock the smart lock, type in the access code provided to you, then push the red button on the bottom of the keypad. To lock the smart lock, hold the red button down. Please note that the smart lock is not set to automatically lock, so you must hold down the red button to lock the door.
- This property is equipped with outdoor security cameras, located on the front doorbell, front yard, backyard, and dock. If you need a copy of a security video due to an incident, please email <u>finnvikgroupllc@gmail.com</u> and provide date and timeframe.

UTILITIES

- Trash and recycling are picked up every Friday. If you are booked for a longer stay, please assist us with placing the bins at the end of the driveway on Thursday evening. Thank you!
- A Shark automatic robot vacuum is located in the dining room. Please feel free to utilize the vacuum (it knows each individual room and will clean the entire main area of the house in approximately 45 minutes). Please pick up any larger items that could be sucked into the vacuum before using.
- Televisions are located in the main room and king bedroom. Both TVs have access to smart apps; feel free to utilize personal accounts to watch television. Be sure to log out before departing.
- Cuisinart and Keurig coffee makers are provided. Please use the provided distilled water to fill either appliance. Disposable filters are also provided for use with the Cuisinart brewing basket.
- A washer and dryer laundry combo are located in the room to the left of the front door. Laundry detergent is provided. Please only use HE detergents if you have a personal preference and want to purchase detergent on own.
- A **propane grill** is provided and located outside the back door. Please reach out to the owner if the propane tank is low, so it can be replaced for you.
