## COVID-19 Vaccine Scheduling

At this time, please **do not** call your provider's office for vaccine scheduling. We look forward to vaccinating as many as people as possible, and to prepare for scheduling your vaccine you should follow the steps below even if you are not currently eligible. If you require special assistance or have difficulty with MyChart, we are working on making other scheduling options available soon.

### **Step 1: Log in or create a [Spectrum Health MyChart account](#).**

We will use Spectrum Health MyChart as a primary means of confirming your eligibility and notifying you when you are able to schedule. You do not need to be a Spectrum Health patient to use this service.

All Spectrum Health MyChart users ages 16 and older will have a COVID-19 Vaccination Questionnaire available to them in their MyChart account. The questionnaire will ask if you are interested in the COVID-19 vaccine and will help us understand what vaccination phase you are in. **Please note: completing this questionnaire does not mean you will be scheduled for an appointment immediately.**

**Step 3: You will receive a MyChart message when you are able to self-schedule your vaccination**

Based on your questionnaire responses, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services vaccine distribution guidance and Spectrum Health's available vaccine supply, you will receive a notification when you are able to self-schedule your vaccine

appointment. Even when you become eligible, appointments may not be available right away, so we continue to ask for your patience.

## COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution Phases

Spectrum Health is working with State and local health departments, area hospitals, pharmacies and other partners to implement the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services plan for a phased approach to distribution.

Groups within 1a, 1b (75 years of age or older and prioritized frontline workers), and 1c (65 years and older) are now eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine as supplies become available. **On January 11 Spectrum Health will begin vaccinating all those 65 years or older.** Based on current guidance from the State of Michigan, prioritized groups of frontline workers will be notified by employers of their eligibility and where they can get a vaccine with an appointment.

A summary of the distribution phases according to Michigan Department of Health and Human Services guidance are listed below. The groups that are eligible for the vaccine starting January 11 are highlighted. For complete descriptions of each phase visit [Michigan.gov](https://www.michigan.gov).

- **Phase 1a**
  - Health care workers
  - Residents of long-term care facilities and staff
- **Phase 1b**
  - Persons 75 years of age or older not covered in Phase 1a
  - Pre-Kindergarten through high school teachers, support staff and child care workers who usually have direct contact with children.
  - First responders not covered in Phase 1A (e.g., firefighters, police, conservation officers, inspectors)
  - Corrections workers (e.g, staff in prisons, jails, juvenile justice facilities)
  - Workers in homeless shelters, congregate child care institutions, and adult and child protective services
  - Other essential frontline workers
- **Phase 1c**
  - People aged 65-74 years old
  - People aged 18-64 years with COVID-19 risk factors/pre-existing conditions
  - All remaining essential workers
  
- **Phase 2 - 16-64 years not covered above.**
