Secretary: Minutes Wassenar, need to correct spelling of Craig's last name. Board minutes, update to 2026. Jamie motioned to approve minutes with changes, Mike Mills 2nd.

President's Report: Wendi reported that the January Waterline went out, and February President's Corner, she attended the February 16 lake dinner at El Rancho.

Treasurer: Jamie noted that we're \$1,100 off budget. We received \$795 from a couple of good 50/50's. Since last meeting have brought in \$1,300 toward Fishplant. She noted that we need to discuss the 4th of July event. We're already over by \$250. Total in bank is \$35,865. She noticed that our interest in the money market isn't accurate and reached out to the branch manager. Motion to accept by Craig, Don 2nd, motion passed.

Committees:

Fish Plant, Signs, Beavers: Don reported that we're going to keep the boat launch code from fall until April.

Lake Sustainability: Chris reported that he's creating an RFP for the next contract, he'll have a draft for review soon. He's planning to meet with Betsy at Oakfield Township to see if anything extra to fit in budget. Planning PLM to test in April.

Welcome Committee: Wendi reported for Phil. There are 30 families in the directory. No new families have been welcomed.

Social: Wendi reported that Candie's daughter is graduating so she's taking a break from managing the Social Committee. Kevin Bird offered to help. Wendi said that Ed will be presenting an idea for July 18 event.

- 4th of July parade is scheduled for July 4.
- Annual Meeting - for this year, Wendi asked if we want to do Thursday Aug 20 or 27th?
- Pancake Breakfast was at Turk Lake last year. Feedback from last year was that members would like it at a facility again. It was discussed having it at Camp Greenwood, Camp Concordia, or Spencer Township. Kim Covell said that she's willing to be the organizer with help. It was discussed that if we can get the volunteers, would prefer that the Board and volunteers do the breakfast rather than have it at a restaurant. It's usually \$100-150 for one

of the camps. Need to have location decided between now and end of March. It would be June 6. Pam asked if people could bring dishes, Wendi said they could. Kris to call Camp Concordia and Spencer Township, Wendi to call Greenwood. Need to know amount and status of facilities for cooking. If the facilities don't work out, then we'll reserve Turk Lake Restaurant. Kim mentioned doing silent auction at breakfast. Kris made a motion that we have the Pancake Breakfast June 6 at one of the facilities depending on availability, cost, and condition, and that if none will work, then we reserve Turk Lake, Deb 2nd, motion passed. When we know which direction, then Wendi will let Faith know so that she can send a notice.

- Plant Sale-Marilyn asked if we are going to do the plant sale. She offered to do it on her property. She offered June 13.
- 4th of July band on south side of Woodbeck-The Ferguson's have reserved the band, Sounds Familiar, for the 4th of July. Need a motion for the board to approve \$400 toward the band. Deb motioned to approve \$400, Kevin Martin 2nd, motion passed.
- 4th of July Boat Parade will be in the morning of the 4th.
- July 18 event with band Flashback. Ed presented an alternative idea to the Progressive Kayaking, with trying to get as many pontoon boats together from Ed's bank to Mike Mills bank for people to walk across. Would be about 900 feet, would need 40 – 45 20ft pontoon boats. Would fall short with the known pontoons on the Banks side, may need alternate boats. Would call it Bank to Bank on Banks. Would have refreshments on both side of the boats. Band is \$600, there wouldn't be a charge. Liability was discussed, Ed said it would be adults only, and the communication would include notifying people that walking boat to boat would be at their own risk. It was asked what if someone wants to get across lake? Ed said that we'd leave it open in the middle until it's time to connect the middle, then it would be blocked for a short duration. Band would start at 2:00 or 3:00 and they play until about 7. Would want to give trial run in April. Don said could put 10 boats together for measurement. People would have to park additional boats or kayaks on shore. Participants would need to rsvp, and people would have to show up at a certain time. Vote needed to do either Poker Kayak or Bank to Bank on Banks. It was voted to do the Poker Kayak. Mike Mills and Don offered to help. It was discussed that we would charge \$10, which is the same as last time, WCLA would pay for the band, and balance goes to association.
