June 12, 2017

Minutes

In attendance: Ruthanne Kohn, Barb Tornholm, Bruce Veldman, Ron Trumble, Don Hoogerhyde, Bob Darvill, Sandy Allers, Tom Hawkinson, Gloria Gibson, Craig Oldenburg, Nan Holmes, Kevin Martin and Tom Stressman.

Meeting was held at Camp Concordia and was called to order at 7:00p by Tom Stressman, President, who welcomed everyone.

Minutes from the May meeting were emailed to the board. Bruce Veldman motioned to approve and Don Hoogerhyde 2nd. Motion passed.

Committee Reports:

Treasurer's Report: Bruce reviewed the treasurer's report. We are up to 195 paid members. The pancake breakfast was held and the net proceeds from that was \$120.00. We sold 5 caps and 1 shirt at the breakfast. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made by Sandy Allers and 2nd by Ron Trumble. Motion passed.

FISH PLANT: We received a new price list from Stoney Creek. Prices are the same as last year. Tom suggested that we only plant walleye this fall. The walleye would be 5-8 inches which would give them a better survival rate. If we only did walleye then we could plant 1,500 to 1,600 of them. Then in the spring we would plant bluegill. We would do a single plant in the spring and then by pass a year. Motion by Bob Darvill, 2nd by Bruce Veldman. Motion passed.

Lake Quality: Bob Darvill stated that PML was out and sprayed. They found a lot of the green algae. They are coming out again on 6/14 to recheck. Ron asked if they could spray the lily pads because the channels are getting out of control. Bruce said they can only spray to clear a path and a small area for swimming. Bob created a flyer to give to rental owner regarding keeping their boats clean.

Welcome Wagon: Bruce stated that Terry visited two new home owners on the lakes.

Monthly Get Together: The monthly get together will be at The Greenharp on June 20th. The next get together is on July 27, 2017 at Clifford Lake Inn at 6:15.

Membership: Nothing new.

Progressive Kayak- Nan stated that the progressive kayak event will be July 15th and the family kayaking event will be June 25th. Details are close to being worked out. There will be a gathering at Norm Davidson's after the progressive kayaking event.

Golf Outing- No update.

New Business: Tom Stressman got a call from a concerned resident about a homeowner on Woodbeck Lake allowing a non-resident of any of the lakes to dock a boat. Sandy knows this person and is going to speak to them and get some details.

Nan Holmes said that she was approached by Carolyn (the cook from Camp Greenwood) about catering the annual meeting. Nan was told that they could do it for much cheaper. Nan is going to speak with Carolyn to get firm numbers as far as cost.

Bruce Veldman contacted the township regarding the fees for lake management. Bruce stated that the fees in both townships are the same. He tried to contact the Oakfield Township regarding the concerns about being over charged. He received an email back but the information he received in that email was unclear. He is going to try to get clarification and will update everyone.

Bruce also mentioned that he will be stepping down as Treasurer and would like others to think about taking his place. Tom Stressman is also stepping down as President. Ron mentioned the possibility of lowering the number of monthly meetings to try and spark interest.

Barb Tornholm mentioned that there is a new DNR map out that shows a DNR trail running through Camp Greenwood property. She was approached by people inquiring about ways to get on the lakes via the trail. She told them that this is private property and there is no public access to these lakes.

Gloria stated that the Waterline will go out in June.

Tom Stressman is going to have his annual party on Saturday, August 12th.
