Updates and Other Stuff:

IF IT's A CHANNEL, GO SLOW, NO WAKE ZONE!!! Please remember to go slowly as you approach, as you go through and as you are leaving a channel. Think of it as nap time, no need to "wake up" when you're in the channel.

Update from the Independent Bridge Committee: An informal group of community members from Woodbeck Chain of Lakes sent out a survey questionnaire regarding interest in raising the Maclain Street Bridge. The many responses they have so far are very favorable. They would like to be sure all home owners have had an opportunity to voice their opinion in the survey before moving forward. Therefore, the survey will be open until August 31st. The WCLA Board remains neutral on this issue but your survey feedback is important.

DUES ARE DUE!!! It's only \$40.00!!! A small price to pay to keep our lakes clean and safe, our fish plentiful and support the fun events we want everyone to enjoy! Water Sustainability Committee: The committee is working closely with PLM and the township to be sure our lakes are getting all needs addressed properly including treatments for weed and algae management. The lakes are in good condition but we do have some invasive weeds which are being treated appropriately by PLM to prevent them from becoming a problem. That has meant treating for the invasive weeds in front of everyone's shoreline. The native plants are only "knocked down" not treated systemically so their root systems remain intact. Surface weeds cannot be treated until after the 1st of July. We believe PLM is on top of the treatment our lakes need at this time.
