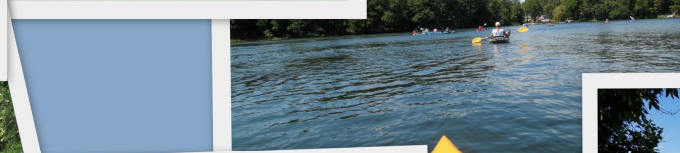
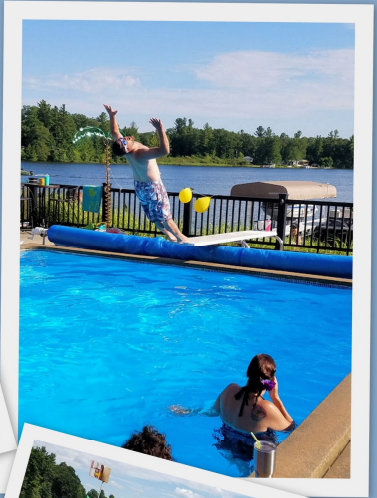
BOAT LAUNCH...

NEW CHANGES TO WCLA BOARD MEETINGS...

- 1) The number of publications will be reduced from 4 to 3 per year, and...
- 2) The Newsletter will only be sent electronically beginning with the November 2017 issue.

Thus it is very important that WCLA have your correct email address so the newsletter can be sent to you. If you have not provided me with your email address you will not be receiving an email notification of the Waterline publication.

The 'e-mail blasts', aka "WCLA Reminders" will continue to be sent informing you that the Waterline is available for viewing with a "pdf" formatted copy included in the email. There will also be a link to the WCLA website where historical copies of Waterlines are stored for your access convenience.

The reasons for these change are two-fold:

1. Eliminate approximately \$1000 of annual expense related to printing, folding, stamping, and mailing 130 or so copies of the Newsletter.
2. Eliminate the need to muster volunteers to do the work.

The new board members will decide at the September 11 Board meeting the 3 dates the Waterline will be published.

Fish Tales by Ron Crame...

As an avid angler, with a passion for fishing for a variety of species, our chain of lakes has provided me with ample opportunities to pursue one of my favorite hobbies. For 16 years, I have resided on Woodbeck Chain of Lakes either full or part time. I have caught just about every kind of fish that swims in our waters. When I learned of the Walleye plants, it further peaked my interest in actively fishing our lakes.

After some, much needed, research on how to catch these formidable opponents, I have pursued them ever since, not because they are easy to catch, but the opposite. I consider it a bonus when I can land a nice Walleye. I'm sure that our neighbors on Woodbeck have caught a glimpse of me trolling along for hours in the morning. I am often out 2-3 mornings a week and average about one Walleye per week. Though more than half of those that I catch are under 15 inches, this seems to show that the stocking program is working very nicely.

To give you a picture, I have caught 300 fish of various species this year alone, and I consider that a "slow year." Although mid-summer is a difficult time to try to catch Walleye, I have found that there are plenty of Bass and Crappie also out there to bend your rod! I hope to see some fellow anglers out on the water!

"OF MOSQUITOES AND KILLER BEES"

There have been many headaches for lakefront property owners in Michigan over the years, particularly with regard to the latest watercraft "toy". During the 1960's and 1970's, the main safety problem on inland lakes was speed boats (with or without water skiers) operated in a fast or unsafe fashion. During the 1980's, the proliferation of jet skis or personal watercraft struck many riparians as a nuisance and safety hazard. Today, riparians are becoming increasingly concerned about the popularity of "wave boats" (also sometimes referred to as bladder boats,

wave runner boats or wakeboard boats). Unfortunately, the impact of wave boats on Michigan inland lakes appears to be dramatically worse than the negative consequences of personal watercraft and conventional speed boats. As one law enforcement officer put it, personal watercraft are mosquitos and problem speed boats are bumble bees, while wave boats are African killer bees!

What is a wave boat? It is a watercraft of speed boat size (or slightly larger in some cases) that uses mechanical means to fill reservoirs (sometimes called "bladders") with water or other liquid to increase the boat's weight and mass, and to raise or lower the boat in the water. Depending upon how a wave boat is operated, it can throw a tremendous wake and create huge artificial waves. In fact, such boats are actually designed and intended to throw huge waves. That is part of the fun associated with these watercraft – they create waves that can be "surfed" by water skiers or wake boarders. **To read more of the article, click on the link below.**

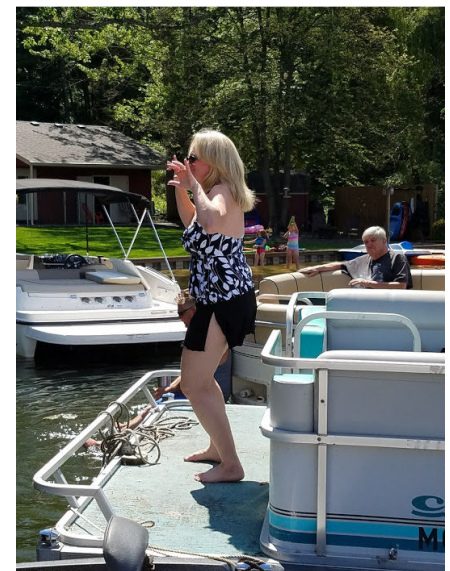

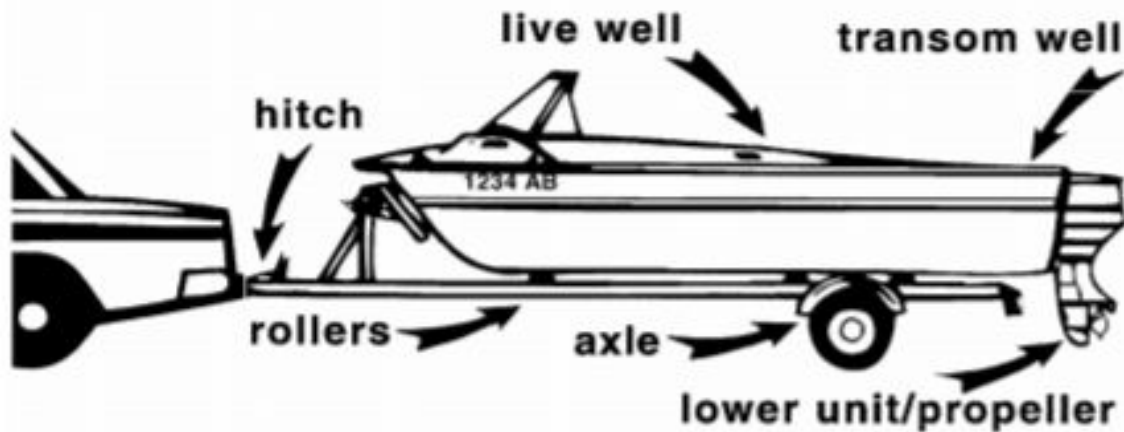
