

PRACTICING SAFTEY ON THE ICE!!!

With winter comes ice – and with our lakes – that means WINTER FUN – RIGHT?? Right! But practicing safety on the water when it's frozen is not only smart – it could save your life and your loved ones!!! Rules to know and follow:

- 1. Know if the ice is thick enough to be safe. Rule of thumb:
 - a. Clear ice with bluish tint and 4" thick is safe to walk on.
 - b. Beware of lakes with water around the edges. It's not safe.
 - c. Stay off ice with slush on top it is not safe.
 - d. Ice should be 6" or more for a snowmobile.
 - e. Never go through a channel. Inflows and Outflows may NEVER totally freeze.
- 2. Always have someone with you! Never go out alone.
- 3. Keep a cell phone on you and keep it charged in a waterproof case.
- 4. Keep ice picks or claws on your belt or snowsuit. These will be necessary if you fall through the ice and need to grab a hold of it to pull yourself out.
- 5. IF YOU FALL THROUGH THE ICE:
 - a. Remain Calm do not panic. Propel yourself to the top of the water.
 - b. Force your ice picks into the ice while stabilizing your body horizontally.
 - c. Pull yourself out of the water. Resist the urge to stand up because you may fall again.
 - d. Get away from the hole by rolling away.
 - e. Call for help immediately. If you had your people with you they are already calling for help.

REMEMBER: Always let others know where you and your group are going to be and how long you plan on being gone! And be mindful of the weather before you head out -know if conditions are such that they could change quickly.
