IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ATTENTION WCLA MEMBERS WHO USE CAMP CONCORDIA'S BOAT LAUNCH

Craig S. Oldenburg, Director of Camp Concordia wrote the following...

Based on insurance needs, Camp Concordia has a new 2021 requirement for WCLA members to use the boat launch. **Before** you can schedule a time to use Camp Concordia's boat launch you must have the attached form on file with their office. The form must be printed off, filled out and mailed to Camp Concordia. The mailing address of Camp Concordia is on the form.

It is a simple form and covers the entire year of 2021, so you only have to file the form once for the entire year.

Change – 2021 WCLA Paid Membership Cards...

In the past, WCLA automatically generated membership cards to paid members who live on the northern lakes (Banks, Thomas, Halfmile) and use Camp Concordia's boat launch. Due to a new Camp Concordia Boat Launch requirement beginning April 1, WCLA will no longer be issuing the membership cards. The WCLA board feels that with the new boat launch change at Camp Concordia, these cards will no longer be needed. But WCLA will continue to provide a most recent copy of the paid members list for cross referencing purposes.

To understand this change, please read the next article below explaining the requirement.

Important Information... continue

Again, the form must be on file with Camp Concordia <u>before</u> you make an appointment to use the launch. This form is related to Insurance needs.

We are grateful for the work the Camp has done with their Insurance carrier to continue to let WCLA members have access to their boat launch.

If you have any possible plan to use the boat launch at Camp Concordia this year, we suggest you complete this form and mail it in... *do it now*, soon you'll be wanting to launch your boat and needing this on file.

Boat Launch Code – Process

Just a reminder... boat launch gate code, at both Kindy Ave and Camp Concordia boat launches changes every month beginning April through October... So plan ahead... If you are a paid member, the code is emailed to you. So, make sure I have your correct email address and check your email at the end of each month for the latest code.

<u>Note:</u> The Kindy Ave boat launch is available now as the lake is ice free – the new code has already been emailed to paid members. This code is good through April 30th. Camp Concordia opens their boat launch on May 1st.






