Healthy recipe: Zucchini Balls

- 2 medium zucchinis (grated) about 3 cups
- ¼ cup onion finely chopped
- 2 large eggs beaten
- ¾ cup Italian bread crumbs
- ¾ cup Parmesan cheese grated
- 2 tablespoons fresh parsley chopped
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ¼ teaspoon black pepper

Instructions:

- Shred zucchini with grater or food processor
- Remove as much excess moisture from the zucchini as possible with paper towels
- Combine shredded zucchini with remaining ingredients in a large mixing bowl
- Scoop and shape the mixture into 1.5-inch balls and place on baking sheet that has been sprayed with oil
- Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes
- Remove and serve with marinara or horseradish dipping sauce
