REMEMBER TO VOTE: August 6^{th in} the Oakfield Primary Election for the **Oakfield Township Supervisor. Two** candidates will be running this year; Greg Dean and Dar Kelly. Even though it's a primary election, whoever wins this election will be the new Township Supervisor. They are both republicans and no democrats are running against them. Our Lake Association and Board work closely with both Oakfield and Spencer Township. Your vote is very important so get out there and vote, vote, vote! I'm told you need to vote straight

ticket if you're voting absentee or it will be thrown out. Please check out the voting rules so your vote is counted.

Bridge Townhall Meeting: A Woodbeck Chain of Lakes Community-wide informational meeting was held at 11:00 am on Saturday, July 13 in the Oakfield Township Hall. The meeting included a brief presentation by an informal group of community members regarding the MacClain Street Bridge and how we can improve passage under the Bridge to better connect our community. The goal was to have a completely transparent process and gather input from the Community. Thank you to the committee and to those who attended. There were many excellent questions asked and all views were respected. You should see a survey questionnaire within the next two weeks either via email or mailed to your house. IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT TO COMPLETE THE SURVEY AND RETURN IT. An email blast will be sent out when the survey goes out as a reminder to watch for it and who to contact if you didn't receive one.

IF IT's A CHANNEL, GO SLOW, NO WAKE ZONE!!! Please remember to go slowly as you approach, as you go through and as you are leaving a channel. Think of it as nap time, no need to "wake up" when you're in the channel.

Water Sustainability Committee: The committee is working closely with PLM and the township to be sure our lakes are getting all needs addressed properly including treatments for weed and algae management. The lakes are in good condition but we do have some invasive weeds which are being treated appropriately by PLM to prevent them from becoming a problem. The native plants are only "knocked down" not treated systemically so their root systems remain intact. Surface weeds cannot be treated until after the 1st of July. We believe PLM is on top of the treatment our lakes need at this time.
