Past Events:


May Social Dinner was another big success with around **30 people** sharing an evening of great food and fun! Although I was not there due to illness, many of you were and I'm told it was a great evening.

Smallmouth Bass Catch and Release

500 Smallmouth Bass, between 5-7" were planted in our lakes two years ago. Our Smallmouth Bass should now be approaching their reproduction and legal possession size of 14". Our goal is to have Smallmouth Bass reproduce naturally in our lakes, so we are asking that **all Smallmouth Bass be released** to reproduce and fight again. Take a picture before releasing your Smallmouth Bass and text it to me at 616-990-8687. Thanks for your help!

Additionally, there will be one walleye plant this fall. More information to follow.

Camp Greenwood destruction of property: The camp has been experiencing an increase in property destruction this spring. If you witness any destruction, please notify Jake Dayringer at 989 330-1204.

Water Sustainability Committee: The committee is working closely with PLM and the township to be sure our lakes are getting all needs addressed properly including treatments for weed and algae management. The lakes are in good condition but we do have some invasive weeds which are being treated appropriately by PLM to prevent them from becoming a problem. The native plants are only "knocked down" not treated systemically so their root systems remain intact. We believe PLM is on top of the treatment our lakes need at this time.
