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In the table below is the listing of players, seeded from highest (#1) to lowest (#32), who are due to play in an Association of Tennis Players (ATP) tournament for women. This tournament has four knockout rounds before the final. In the first round, the highest-seeded player plays the lowest-seeded player (seed #32), designated match No. 1 of the first round; the 2nd-seeded player plays the 31st-seeded player, designated match No. 2 of the first round, and so on. Thus, for instance, match No. 16 of the first round is to be played between the 16th-seeded player and the 17th-seeded player. In the second round, the winner of match No. 1 of the first round plays the winner of match No. 16 of the first round and is designated match No. 1 of the second round. Similarly, the winner of match No. 2 of the first round plays the winner of match No. 15 of the first round and is designated match No. 2 of the second round. Thus, for instance, match No.8 of the second round will be played between the winner of match No. 8 of the first round and the winner of match No. 9 of the first round. The same pattern is followed for later rounds as well.

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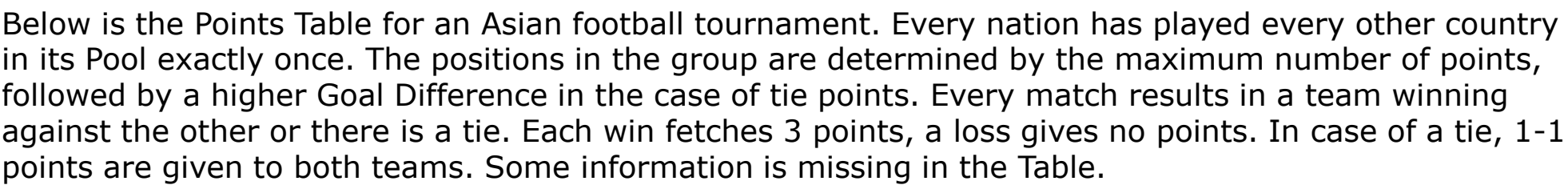

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Volleyball matches are played in five sets. The first four sets are played to 25 points, with the final set being played to 15 points. A team must win a set by at least two points. There is no ceiling, so a set continues until one of the teams gains a two-point advantage. A match was played between India and Pakistan in which-

- Only three sets finished with the minimum threshold points.
- The total score of the five sets of India and Pakistan were 108 and 116 respectively. However, India won 3 sets.
- The score of India in one of the sets was the same as the score of Pakistan in one of the other sets. Both of them lost their respective sets by a different margin.
- Pakistan scored 23 points in one of the sets.
- The score of Pakistan was the same in two of the sets in which it won one of the sets.
- In one of the sets, the final score of India was less than half of Pakistan's.
- There were only three sets in which a team won by exactly a two-point advantage.
- The maximum score by any team in the five sets was 30 and the minimum was 12.

- Ross came 3rd in the first game and 4th in the second game.
- Only in the first and the fifth games Diana get a better rank than Fred.
